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Introduction

The Question of All Questions Today: **Are You Heaven-Ready?**

My Question is specifically aimed towards Christians and not towards the sinner.

I am not asking this question in general to the sinful world. This question is for the Christian!

This is a straightforward question to you, **“The Christian.”**

Are You Heaven-Ready?

This question may generate several answers, but are you really ready?

You might say, “Yes, I am heaven-ready. I am redeemed because I’ve accepted Jesus as my personal Saviour. Or you might say, “Yes, I’m a Christian and live a life that is led by the example the Bible teaches.

Or even, “Yes, because I am forgiven, do good to others, pray and read my Bible often and I even go to church regularly.”

Whatever your answer may be; Jesus says to his disciples:

Mat 7:13 Enter ye in at the strait gate: for wide is the gate, and broad is the way, that leadeth to destruction, and many there be which go in there at:

Mat 7:14 Because strait is the gate, and narrow is the way, which leadeth unto life, and few there be that find it.

Only a few will find and enter heaven.

Jesus answers Nicodemus after he raised a question to Jesus:

Joh 3:3 Jesus answered and said unto him, Verily, verily, I say unto thee, Except a man be born again, he cannot see the kingdom of God.

We may be like Nicodemus, a spiritual leader with Bible knowledge but we need to know what is required of us in order for us to be able to enter the Kingdom of Heaven.

What are the criteria and requirements to inherit the Kingdom of Heaven as your home one day?

Jesus lays out the constitution of Heaven and tells us exactly what we need to do to enter the Kingdom of God.

Joh 3:5 Jesus answered, Verily, verily, I say unto thee, Except a man be born of water and *of* the Spirit, he cannot enter into the kingdom of God.

Joh 3:6 That which is born of the flesh is flesh; and that which is born of the Spirit is spirit.

Chapter 1: See the Kingdom Of God

In John 3, Jesus mentions that if we only want to see the Kingdom of God / Heaven - we need to be re-born or born again.

Later in John 3 v 5 Jesus says to Nicodemus that if he wants to enter the Kingdom of Heaven, he needs to be baptized in water and in the Spirit.

We as Christians understand this answer Jesus gave to Nicodemus. In this book, we will look at the steps that we have to take to eventually get Heaven-ready.

We will call this: **the guidelines to become Heaven-ready.**

Jesus was the only one that was sent to Earth from the Kingdom of Heaven and the one who returned to it again in full glory.

So we need to study Jesus and see how a citizen of the Kingdom of Heaven should react, talk, live and be as a whole.

If we want to become citizens of Heaven, we need to follow Jesus' example. We need to learn how we ought to live, react, be....

Jesus, the only citizen of Heaven, came to Earth, so let's follow His example and see how we ought to live in order for us to become approved citizens of Heaven.

How do I become Heaven-Ready?

Jesus' ministry started here on earth with the mountain sermon where He gave us the constitution of the Kingdom of God / Heaven.

In Matt 5 v 1-12 and Luke 6 v 17-49

Mat 5:1 And seeing the multitudes, he went up into a mountain: and when he was set, his disciples came unto him:

Mat 5:2 And he opened his mouth, and taught them, saying,

Mat 5:3 Blessed *are* the poor in spirit: for theirs is the kingdom of heaven.

Mat 5:4 Blessed *are* they that mourn: for they shall be comforted.

Mat 5:5 Blessed *are* the meek: for they shall inherit the earth.

Mat 5:6 Blessed *are* they which do hunger and thirst after righteousness: for they shall be filled.

Mat 5:7 Blessed *are* the merciful: for they shall obtain mercy.

Mat 5:8 Blessed *are* the pure in heart: for they shall see God.

Mat 5:9 Blessed *are* the peacemakers: for they shall be called the children of God.

Mat 5:10 Blessed *are* they which are persecuted for righteousness' sake: for theirs is the kingdom of heaven.

Mat 5:11 Blessed are ye, when *men* shall revile you, and persecute *you*, and shall say all manner of evil against you falsely, for my sake.

Mat 5:12 Rejoice, and be exceeding glad: for great is your reward in heaven: for so persecuted they the prophets which were before you.

The rules and regulations of Heaven, or as I call it = The **Be-attitudes**.

The **attitude** you should have, to one day, **be** in Heaven.

Jesus - the Only Citizen From Heaven Send To Us By God The Father.

It was almost too late when Jesus' disciples comprehended the Kingdom vision. They even argued at some point about who the most important person in the Kingdom Of Heaven is (Luke 22 v 25-27; Mark 10 v 35-45; John 13 v 14-15 and also in Luke 18 v 16-17).

Luk 22:25 And he said unto them, The kings of the Gentiles exercise lordship over them; and they that exercise authority upon them are called benefactors.

Luk 22:26 But ye *shall not be* so: but he that is greatest among you, let him be as the younger; and he that is chief, as he that doth serve.

Luk 22:27 For whether is greater, he that sitteth at meat, or he that serveth? is not he that sitteth at meat? but I am among you as he that serveth.

Jesus then called a child forward and used the child as an example:

Mat 18:1 At the same time came the disciples unto Jesus, saying, Who is the greatest in the kingdom of heaven?

Mat 18:2 And Jesus called a little child unto him, and set him in the midst of them,

Mat 18:3 And said, Verily I say unto you, Except ye be converted, and become as little children, ye shall not enter into the kingdom of heaven.

Mat 18:4 Whosoever therefore shall humble himself as this little child, the same is greatest in the kingdom of heaven.

Mat 18:5 And whoso shall receive one such little child in my name receiveth me.

Mat 18:6 But whoso shall offend one of these little ones which believe in me, it were better for him that a millstone were hanged about his neck, and *that* he were drowned in the depth of the sea.

Mat 18:7 Woe unto the world because of offences! for it must needs be that offences come; but woe to that man by whom the offence cometh!

Mat 18:8 Wherefore if thy hand or thy foot offend thee, cut them off, and cast *them* from thee: it is better for thee to enter into life halt or maimed, rather than having two hands or two feet to be cast into everlasting fire.

Mat 18:9 And if thine eye offend thee, pluck it out, and cast *it* from thee: it is better for thee to enter into life with one eye, rather than having two eyes to be cast into hell fire.

Mat 18:10 Take heed that ye despise not one of these little ones; for I say unto you, That in heaven their angels do always behold the face of my Father which is in heaven.

Mat 18:11 For the Son of man is come to save that which was lost.

Mat 18:12 How think ye? if a man have an hundred sheep, and one of them be gone astray, doth he not leave the ninety and nine, and goeth into the mountains, and seeketh that which is gone astray?

Mat 18:13 And if so be that he find it, verily I say unto you, he rejoiceth more of that *sheep*, than of the ninety and nine which went not astray.

Mat 18:14 Even so it is not the will of your Father which is in heaven, that one of these little ones should perish.

This simply means we need to look at Jesus and the characteristics of a child to find the secrets to the constitution of Heaven.

Let's look at the characteristics of a Child:

1. Children are wholly dependent on their parents or caregivers for everything.
2. They have an unwavering faith and hope in their parents or caregivers.
3. They are honest and have a teachable nature.
4. They are eager to learn.
5. They respond well to discipline and are respectful towards their parents or caregivers (or at least they should be).
6. They are humble.

This is also the characteristics of a person that is poor in spirit that we will discuss later on.

So is Jesus our number one example? YES

Characteristics of Jesus:

Php 2:7 But made himself of no reputation, and took upon him the form of a servant, and was made in the likeness of men:

Php 2:8 And being found in fashion as a man, he humbled himself, and became obedient unto death, even the death of the cross.

1. Jesus gave up His Godliness and status in heaven and came to earth to die for our sins.
2. Jesus accepted the form of man and became flesh in order to become a servant.
3. Jesus humbled Himself to come to a sinful world.
4. Jesus was guilt free, but still obedient and willing to die for us in the most inhumane way of all which is crucifixion, and He did it, willingly, for our sins.
5. According to John 4 v 34, Heb 10 v 7 and Matt 26 v 39-42 Jesus was totally dependent on His Father; God.
6. Jesus was dependent on God in all things and He always sought God's will above all else (John 5 v 30).
7. Jesus humbled Himself to wash the feet of His disciples (John 13 v 5).
8. Jesus was soft-hearted and humble (Matt 11 v 29).

Let's take Jesus as our only example.

How to become a true Citizen of the Kingdom of God / Heaven - our promise to eternal life.

We see in Matt 5 v 1-14

The points of the constitution of Heaven.

Let's look at these.

- Kingdom Attitude
- Kingdom Power Released
- Kingdom Discipline
- Kingdom Desires
- Kingdom Method
- Kingdom Motivation
- Kingdom Work Ethic
- Kingdom Identification

Chapter 2: Kingdom Attitude-Behaviour

Mat 5:3 Blessed *are* the poor in spirit: for theirs is the kingdom of heaven.

What an abundance of wondrous joy we will receive upon the revelation of our spirit, and if we place all our hope and faith in Jesus Christ, our daily source for life, and if we live our lives according to His example in order for us to become citizens of Heaven. Our spirit will reveal the Truth according to the word of God “To them is given the inheritance of Heaven.” We inherit it from Jesus, for we are co-inheritors with Christ.

This is what it means to be poor in spirit; to be humble in Christ. It means you are totally dependent on God for anything and everything.

We read early on in God’s Word (the Bible) about a heart of stone. He (God) hardened his (Pharaoh’s) heart and so God had to send plaques to soften his heart (Exodus 7 -14)

We all know that the ‘heart’ the Bible mentions here is actually your soul or the spirit of man and this actually means that Pharaoh had a hardened spirit and these people had to suffer because of his hardened spirit.

Just think, things would have been so different if Pharaoh had a softer spirit. But then on the other hand, it wouldn’t have made a difference really, because God hardened Pharaoh’s heart (spirit) in order for Him to show the Israelites His Mighty Hand.

Pharaoh’s hardened spirit and his rebellion towards God’s commands continued to a point where Pharaoh had to lose his beloved son to death, purposefully portraying how God would give His own beloved Son to die for our sin one day.

This hardened spirit of Pharaoh was the reason for his heartache (Ex 7 v 10 -12)

Exo 7:10 And Moses and Aaron went in unto Pharaoh, and they did so as the LORD had commanded: and Aaron cast down his rod before Pharaoh, and before his servants, and it became a serpent.

Exo 7:11 Then Pharaoh also called the wise men and the sorcerers: now the magicians of Egypt, they also did in like manner with their enchantments.

Exo 7:12 For they cast down every man his rod, and they became serpents: but Aaron's rod swallowed up their rods.

This hardened spirit was always with man and will be with us until it ends at the Great White Throne Judgment and then even then there will be Christians that will argue about their inheritance of the pool of fire (Hell) (Matt 7 v 21-23).

Mat 7:21 Not every one that saith unto me, Lord, Lord, shall enter into the kingdom of heaven; but he that doeth the will of my Father which is in heaven.
Mat 7:22 Many will say to me in that day, Lord, Lord, have we not prophesied in thy name? and in thy name have cast out devils? and in thy name done many wonderful works?
Mat 7:23 And then will I profess unto them, I never knew you: depart from me, ye that work iniquity.

Just the opposite of Pharaoh, is Moses, an example of somebody that was poor in spirit, who had a soft spirit.

When God gave Moses the instructions to tell Pharaoh, "Let my people go," Moses felt too small to be God's messenger (Ex 3 v 11)
God's answer to him: **"I will be with you"**

If we too become poor in the spirit, we will realise that we cannot do anything without Jesus and God in our lives, we will not even receive the baptism and guidance of the Holy Spirit to take on anything without God's guidance via the Holy Spirit.

Those with a poor spirit, who listens to God's voice and wait for His guidance, will become strong in the spirit (Isaiah 66 v 5) Listen to the Word of God, and then only react in a way that will bring glory to God's name.

Isa 66:5 Hear the word of the LORD, ye that tremble at his word; Your brethren that hated you, that cast you out for my name's sake, said, Let the LORD be glorified: but he shall appear to your joy, and they shall be ashamed.

Poor in the spirit also means to find shelter at God and Jesus' feet and to seek protection from Him
(Ps 2 v 11 -12).

Psa 2:11 Serve the LORD with fear, and rejoice with trembling.
Psa 2:12 Kiss the Son, lest he be angry, and ye perish *from* the way, when his wrath is kindled but a little. Blessed *are* all they that put their trust in him.

God is our protection in times of distraught. He will keep us save when we are weak and poor in the spirit.

Jesus set the perfect example of being poor in the spirit; rather be the servant than the master, rather be the humble one than the one with pride, rather a slave than a king (Luke 22 v 25-27)

Luk 22:25 And he said unto them, The kings of the Gentiles exercise lordship over them; and they that exercise authority upon them are called benefactors.
Luk 22:26 But ye *shall not be* so: but he that is greatest among you, let him be as the younger; and he that is chief, as he that doth serve.
Luk 22:27 For whether is greater, he that sitteth at meat, or he that serveth? is not he that sitteth at meat? but I am among you as he that serveth.

Poor in the spirit also means to be dependent on God for His guidance, security, His gifts and even healing of the body and mind.
But all this is not possible without faith.

Faith in God, faith in Jesus and faith in the Holy Spirit.

Without faith, how can we run to the protection of the Rock, if we don't believe the rock can give us safety from danger?

How will we rest assure that God will provide for us if we don't believe in God? The same principle applies when we need Godly Healing; we first need to believe that He is our Healer.

Faith is very important to feed a poor spirit. Persistent Prayer in faith is proof when a person is poor spirit

Waiting on God's answers, trusting Him for provision and healing and to be completely dependent on God for everything else in your life, you need to have faith.

Heb 11:6 But without faith *it is impossible to please him*: for he that cometh to God must believe that he is, and *that* he is a rewarder of them that diligently seek him.

To wait on God (long suffering) is a character trait of a child of God. It is also a fruit of the Spirit of God.

Gal 5:22 But the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, longsuffering, gentleness, goodness, faith,
Gal 5:23 Meekness, temperance: against such there is no law.

God's time is not our time.

God is the provider and His time is perfect and the outcome is also planned to the point of perfection and these perfectly planned outcomes are what we call: miracles.

I always say that even though it may sometimes look like God will be late or maybe He is already too late with the answer, and sometimes it just feels as if God has forgotten about us and just before we reach the point where we want to give up, God comes through and provides the answers and it is usually followed by a perfectly planned miracle.

The miracle will be more than we can ever think or plan or even dream of ourselves.

God knows what we need, before we even ask Him.

Lazarus was already 4 days in the grave when Jesus came walking down the dusty road.

It may seem that it is already too late, but God and Jesus are always on time.

Isa 40:31 But they that wait upon the LORD shall renew *their* strength; they shall mount up with wings as eagles; they shall run, and not be weary; *and* they shall walk, and not faint.

Those who are poor in the spirit are chosen for the Kingdom of God and they will be appointed as leaders within the Kingdom of God according to the second chapter of 1 Peter, verse nine.

1Pe 2:9 But ye *are* a chosen generation, a royal priesthood, an holy nation, a peculiar people; that ye should shew forth the praises of him who hath called you out of darkness into his marvellous light:

Be humble on Earth and you will be exalted in the Kingdom of Heaven. This message in the Bible couldn't be clearer; **if you are less, you will become more:**

Servant becomes Master, slave becomes King.

We will become kings and priests in Heaven. What a promise!

Jesus' promise to us as children of God is that we are co-inheritors along with Jesus; we are the heirs of the Father.

And when we die, we will be raised at the Rapture and soon we will be with Jesus in the Kingdom of Heaven.

Eph 2:6 And hath raised *us* up together, and made *us* sit together in heavenly places in Christ Jesus:

Any losses or sufferings that we endure on earth will not be mourned over when we are Spirit-filled children of God.

For our gifts and purity in Heaven with eternal inheritance in Heaven will wipe the Tears

Heb 10:34 For ye had compassion of me in my bonds, and took joyfully the spoiling of your goods, knowing in yourselves that ye have in heaven a better and an enduring substance.

The story of Job shows us an excellent example of how we should react to trials and tribulations.

Job's children died, his wife left him, and he lost all his earthly possessions, and yet he remained poor in the spirit. He trusted God for provision, stood firm on his love for God and God's love for him and he kept on praying and believing and hoping in God for healing of his body and the restoration of his life (Job chapter 1 and 2).

We know that God loves us, and we know that if God loves us then all will be according to His will

Rom 8:28 And we know that all things work together for good to them that love God, to them who are the called according to *his* purpose.

This Psalmist says that when he was sick, he prayed and trusted and then healing took place. He spoke POWER into a poor spirit.

Psa 35:13 But as for me, when they were sick, my clothing *was* sackcloth: I humbled my soul with fasting; and my prayer returned into mine own bosom.

Humble yourself and wait on God and in God's time you will receive.

Mat 23:11 But he that is greatest among you shall be your servant.

Mat 23:12 And whosoever shall exalt himself shall be abased; and he that shall humble himself shall be exalted.

1Pe 5:6 Humble yourselves therefore under the mighty hand of God, that he may exalt you in due time:

Even Paul had to be humbled in order for him to be exalted in Christ.

Act 9:1 And Saul, yet breathing out threatenings and slaughter against the disciples of the Lord, went unto the high priest,

Act 9:2 And desired of him letters to Damascus to the synagogues, that if he found any of this way, whether they were men or women, he might bring them bound unto Jerusalem.

Act 9:3 And as he journeyed, he came near Damascus: and suddenly there shined round about him a light from heaven:

Act 9:4 And he fell to the earth, and heard a voice saying unto him, Saul, Saul, why persecutest thou me?

Act 9:5 And he said, Who art thou, Lord? And the Lord said, I am Jesus whom thou persecutest: *it is hard for thee to kick against the pricks.*

Act 9:6 And he trembling and astonished said, Lord, what wilt thou have me to do? And the Lord *said* unto him, Arise, and go into the city, and it shall be told thee what thou must do.

Even if we go into The Tribulation period during our lifetime, we don't need to worry about anything, because everything is already planned to perfection by God.

If we humble ourselves, we only need to wait on God for the answer. (Luke 18 v 1-8)

Jesus' advice to us is to never cease praying.

We see this example throughout the Bible.

Here is a very good example of God's provision:

Deu 8:2 And thou shalt remember all the way which the LORD thy God led thee these forty years in the wilderness, to humble thee, *and* to prove thee, to know what *was* in thine heart, whether thou wouldest keep his commandments, or no.

Deu 8:16 Who fed thee in the wilderness with manna, which thy fathers knew not, that he might humble thee, and that he might prove thee, to do thee good at thy latter end;

To be poor in the spirit is better than to be prideful towards God; I experienced this myself in my life. **Don't exalt yourself!**

Heb 10:31 *It is a fearful thing to fall into the hands of the living God.*

Jesus says: "Follow my example. Stay in me as I stay in the Father."

Joh 15:1 I am the true vine, and my Father is the husbandman.

Joh 15:2 Every branch in me that beareth not fruit he taketh away: and every *branch* that beareth fruit, he purgeth it, that it may bring forth more fruit.

Joh 15:3 Now ye are clean through the word which I have spoken unto you.

Joh 15:4 Abide in me, and I in you. As the branch cannot bear fruit of itself, except it abide in the vine; no more can ye, except ye abide in me.

Joh 15:5 I am the vine, ye *are* the branches: He that abideth in me, and I in him, the same bringeth forth much fruit: for without me ye can do nothing.

Joh 15:6 If a man abide not in me, he is cast forth as a branch, and is withered; and men gather them, and cast *them* into the fire, and they are burned.

Joh 15:7 If ye abide in me, and my words abide in you, ye shall ask what ye will, and it shall be done unto you.

Let's follow Jesus as our only example: be poor in the spirit, humble ourselves and rely on God for everything. We need to adopt this Kingdom behaviour, so that we can enter the Kingdom of Heaven.

This Kingdom behaviour is characteristic of that of a citizen of Heaven, and it is our starting block for our race to Heaven.

Chapter 3: Kingdom Power Release

(Matt 5 v 4) God blesses those who mourn for they will be comforted:

Spiritual growth and well-being and sheer joy is the mark of citizenship of a person of the Kingdom of Heaven, where your relationship with God is consistently broken in the spirit - this is the secret, YOU will receive power and comforting from God's spirit

Isa 61:3 To appoint unto them that mourn in Zion, to give unto them beauty for ashes, the oil of joy for mourning, the garment of praise for the spirit of heaviness; that they might be called trees of righteousness, the planting of the LORD, that he might be glorified.

We know this well, Jesus says we actually have to cry when we need to laugh and be mournful when we smile and the other way around. This is the secret of the spiritual world.

One day in Heaven or on the New Earth, We will see that if we mourn its well with our soul, joy will turn to tears and tears will turn to joy.

I have learned in my life that God understands all the languages in the world; Greek, German, French, Zulu and all the other languages that you've never even heard about.

But there is one language God understands the best and that is the language of tears.

I can personally attest to this.

The most flawless, yet unspoken language = **Tears.**

Tears come from the heart, spirit, soul and the mind and this is the language that God understands the best.

Now this undoubtedly RAISED a question in you.

Does God see our tears?

The Bible says that God captures the tears of the righteous and keeps them safe. Tears are a source of pain, suffering and heartache and come straight from your heart/ spirit in pureness.

Your tears are like an encoded message from your spirit directly to God and God Himself acts on these tears.

Sometimes it's good to just cry to God - no words are required and you don't have to organise your thoughts; just tears.
And when we are thankful, we thank God with tears of joy.

Jas 4:9 Be afflicted, and mourn, and weep: let your laughter be turned to mourning, and *your* joy to heaviness.

Jas 4:10 Humble yourselves in the sight of the Lord, and he shall lift you up.

Cry, let your tears flow freely, and humble yourself before God and God will answer.

Paul affirms this: humble yourself and cry before God.

2Co 12:21 *And* lest, when I come again, my God will humble me among you, and *that* I shall bewail many which have sinned already, and have not repented of the uncleanness and fornication and lasciviousness which they have committed.

Pureness in brokenness turns into joy when you activate your citizenship power release in the kingdom of God.

We become strong when we are weak.

Spiritual Power increases when we shed a tear from the soul.

Even Satan starts running around in panic, when we as children of God cry.

Because he knows that the wheels of Heaven go into action, when this happens

Php 3:20 For our conversation is in heaven; from whence also we look for the Saviour, the Lord Jesus Christ:

Php 3:21 Who shall change our vile body, that it may be fashioned like unto his glorious body, according to the working whereby he is able even to subdue all things unto himself.

When we cry in humbleness, it will change into glorious joy in Heaven and this is power release of Kingdom citizen's.

Yes when I cry, good things will come from Heaven but it needs to come from the heart and God will answer.

Rom 8:28 And we know that all things work together for good to them that love God, to them who are the called according to *his* purpose.

Even when God punishes us for our sin, we need to cry tears of joy.

Heb 12:5 And ye have forgotten the exhortation which speaketh unto you as unto children, My son, despise not thou the chastening of the Lord, nor faint when thou art rebuked of him:

Heb 12:6 For whom the Lord loveth he chasteneth, and scourgeth every son whom he receiveth.

Heb 12:7 If ye endure chastening, God dealeth with you as with sons; for what son is he whom the father chasteneth not?

Heb 12:8 But if ye be without chastisement, whereof all are partakers, then are ye bastards, and not sons.

Heb 12:9 Furthermore we have had fathers of our flesh which corrected *us*, and we gave *them* reverence: shall we not much rather be in subjection unto the Father of spirits, and live?

Heb 12:10 For they verily for a few days chastened *us* after their own pleasure; but he for *our* profit, that *we* might be partakers of his holiness.

Heb 12:11 Now no chastening for the present seemeth to be joyous, but grievous: nevertheless afterward it yieldeth the peaceable fruit of righteousness unto them which are exercised thereby.

And joy is a fruit of the Spirit of God (Gal 5 v 22 - 23)

The Spirit of God gives freedom and when we receive a refilling of the Holy Spirit, we become more like Jesus. There are 7 Spirits of God, and every time we receive a refilling of the Holy Spirit, we receive one of these 7 Spirits of God. (See my eBook "Not Just a Spirit")

We need to change our lives daily in order to become more like Jesus.

2Co 3:17 Now the Lord is that Spirit: and where the Spirit of the Lord is, there is liberty.

2Co 3:18 But we all, with open face beholding as in a glass the glory of the Lord, are changed into the same image from glory to glory, *even* as by the Spirit of the Lord.

It is not our human nature to understand these things, because we ruminate with our minds.

Everything about God the Father, Jesus the Son and the Holy Spirit is far too big for our human minds to comprehend.

The Holy Spirit reveals to us the things the human mind cannot comprehend and illuminates the spiritual world to us.

Just as Jesus is the bread of life, the Bible, God's Word is also the bread of life and we need the Holy Spirit to open the Word of God to us.

We need to be in the spirit to understand the things of the Spirit.

1Co 2:14 But the natural man receiveth not the things of the Spirit of God: for they are foolishness unto him: neither can he know *them*, because they are spiritually discerned.

Jesus came to save us from sin and eternal punishment but now that Jesus is back in Heaven

The Holy Spirit was sent to earth to be with us.

Eph 2:1 And you *hath he quickened*, who were dead in trespasses and sins;

Eph 2:2 Wherein in time past ye walked according to the course of this world, according to the prince of the power of the air, the spirit that now worketh in the children of disobedience:

Eph 2:3 Among whom also we all had our conversation in times past in the lusts of our flesh, fulfilling the desires of the flesh and of the mind; and were by nature the children of wrath, even as others.

Eph 2:4 But God, who is rich in mercy, for his great love wherewith he loved us,

Eph 2:5 Even when we were dead in sins, hath quickened us together with Christ, (by grace ye are saved;)

Jesus wants us to make extra sure that we teach the newly born Christian all the things he taught His disciples, just as we read in Matthew 28:

Mat 28:19 Go ye therefore, and teach all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Ghost:

Mat 28:20 Teaching them to observe all things whatsoever I have commanded you: and, lo, I am with you always, *even* unto the end of the world. Amen.

Go and make new-born children of God from all the nations and baptize them in the Holy Spirit and teach them as the Master teacher, Jesus, taught His disciples.

Even Jesus received the Baptism.

After you're received the Holy Spirit Baptism with fire according to (Acts 2 v 1-4), you will find that the Word of God (the Bible) becomes alive and active, because the Holy Spirit reveals the things that were previously incomprehensible and brings clarity to the Word of God.

We know that according to 2 Tim 3:16 that all scripture is breathed out by God, which means that the Word of God is inspired by the Spirit of God and if you

have the Spirit of God living in you, the Word will be revealed to you as it was revealed to the writers who originally wrote the 66 books of the Bible. In other words, the Holy Spirit will reveal the Author (God) of the Book (The Bible) to you.

Jesus says we need to make sure that they (the new-born Christians) follow all the steps before they can become disciples themselves.

Too often Christians are eager to make new disciples without being first disciple themselves. They would lead people to Jesus but then leave the new-born Christians to feed and fend for themselves.

A hit and run scenario. We like to Evangelize and see beautiful Born again Christians to the Lord but we don't want to continue with the larger point of Jesus instruction to us, ANSWER; we need to take each one of our new Born through the 12 steps of Heaven and make sure they reach step 10 discipleship (in my Book – Living with Eternity on my Mind)

My Prayer is that no child of God will leave the new born Christian on their own because they will be eaten by the wolves and will not make Heaven! According to 1 Peter 5:8 the devil is like a roaring lion, sneaking around to find someone to devour.

Yes, these are harsh words, but we need to understand the importance of this and we need to take responsibility for our actions.

We cannot allow this to happen!

We need to take the newly reborn Christian through all 12 steps to heaven where we will spend our eternal life.

Step 1- Admitting you're a sinner

Step 2- Turning away from sin

Step 3- Accepting Jesus as your Saviour

Step 4- Faith in God, Jesus and Holy Spirit

Step 5- Receiving and giving forgiveness

Step 6- Baptism of water (Born Again or Reborn)

Step 7- Study the Word of God, Bible study

Step 8- Prayer; build on Faith and continual forgiveness

Step 9- Baptism in the Holy Spirit (extremely important step)

Step 10- Accepting your Discipleship

Step 11- Sealed for eternity

Step 12- Heaven our home

Our teacher, Jesus placed emphasis on this - **makes sure of this** (Matt 28 v 19 - 20)

Confirmed in (Gal 1 v 16, Rom 6 v 6 and Gal 2 v 20).

Yes! You could be the reason why somebody doesn't make it to Heaven or the reason why that person's name never appears in the book of life.

Walk the extra mile with the new born you have led to the Lord. Make sure the person reaches step 10 at the very least, before you can step back, because then the Holy Spirit will be there to guide the person the rest of the way to heaven.

Yes, there will be people in this world that will not make it!!!!

But at least their blood will not be on your hands.

God gave all people their own free will and all you can do, is to place the lost soul at Jesus' feet.

Even Jesus wasn't welcome in some places.

Mat 8:34 And, behold, the whole city came out to meet Jesus: and when they saw him, they besought *him* that he would depart out of their coasts.

I know it's time consuming to take each person from step 1 to step 10 of the 12 steps to heaven, but this is Jesus' instruction to us.

"Take up your Cross daily and follow Me", Jesus says.

"Follow me and then help others to also follow me".

Luk 9:23 And he said to *them* all, If any *man* will come after me, let him deny himself, and take up his cross daily, and follow me.

Mat 10:38 And he that taketh not his cross, and followeth after me, is not worthy of me.

The Psalmist calls out: "Help me Lord, and the lord is there to help."

Do we help others? We should always be ready to serve others. But are we?

Psa 34:18 The LORD is nigh unto them that are of a broken heart; and saveth such as be of a contrite spirit.

After the baptism of the Holy Spirit, you need to allow the Holy Spirit to lead you through the instructions from Jesus.

Do it in the spirit with the divine help from the Holy Spirit.

Rom 8:5 For they that are after the flesh do mind the things of the flesh; but they that are after the Spirit the things of the Spirit.

Rom 8:6 For to be carnally minded *is* death; but to be spiritually minded *is* life and peace.

Rom 8:7 Because the carnal mind *is* enmity against God: for it is not subject to the law of God, neither indeed can be.

Rom 8:8 So then they that are in the flesh cannot please God.

Paul says, “Be glad to assist.”

Rom 7:22 For I delight in the law of God after the inward man:

Paul led several Churches through the 12 steps to Heaven. There are sinners out there waiting in anticipation for you to lead them through the 12 steps.

Rom 8:19 For the earnest expectation of the creature waiteth for the manifestation of the sons of God.

Jump into action, follow the steps yourself, and make sure you did not skip a step, because you won't be able to move to the next important step in your life if you haven't completely and fully mastered each and every step. And then only can you continue on to the next step. And only after you have completed all the steps (1 to 11, because step 12 is eternal life in heaven), you can now take the new born Christian through the steps. Walk with them, step by step, until you are certain that they have been sealed for eternal life. Coaching them one-on-one is the best method and the surest road to a successful discipleship.

Jesus will wash your feet just as Mary washed Jesus' feet.

Please wipe away the tears that we have cried from carrying our crosses and
comfort us with your Spirit and helps us to lead others.
Please give the new disciples the same hunger as we have for new-born souls.

Lord we know that tears are the language of Heaven and that You understand
tears better than any other language on Earth and You will wipe away our tears
Yourself.

We praise you, Our Great God, for the gentleness of the Holy Spirit within us.

Amen and Amen.

Chapter 4: Kingdom Discipline.

Mat 5:5 Blessed *are* the meek: for they shall inherit the earth.

God blesses those who are gentle and lonely for the whole earth will belong to them.

Even when life threatens you with unfair and circumstance and turn against you. Allow the Holy Spirit to transform your spirit to total joy and allow the Holy Spirit to lead you so that your spirit can grow and become more sensitive to the voice of the Holy Spirit.

The Baptism of the Holy Spirit is very important in a Child of God's life and after the Baptism a regular re filling of the precious oil of the Holy Spirit. Yes we need to become full of the Spirit and build on the fruits of the Spirit until we sin no more in your life.

Building on the fruit as per **(Gal 5 v 22 - 23)**

In (Gal 5 v 22 - 23) every of the fruit a book by itself, but we need to know that these fruits and all of them have to be present in a child of God's life. And are part of the discipline and Circumstance of a citizen of Heaven.

This discipline is important, so is the baptism of the Holy Spirit. So that we can be discipline not to sin, and build on prayer, bible study, faith, forgiveness and continues filling of the Holy Spirit and all 7 Spirits of God.

With the Baptism of the Holy Spirit **(1 Cor 12)** mentions that we will receive Gifts from the Holy Spirit.

This gift is given to the newly spirit filled child of God to help him or her with their discipleship and even to help us in our ministry. Sometimes your gift you received becomes your ministry.

The gifts of the Spirit is also very important when children of God come together of meeting, church services , Home cell's or even prayer meeting.

Just as the Holy Spirit gives these gifts, they can only be used to comfort, uplift or boost follow children of God and vice versa.

I would like to point at sensitivity and tenderness to be sensitive to the voice of the Holy Spirit in your live and to use this gift to bring tenderness of the people of God.

(Rom 8 v 14)

The ones that are led by the Holy Spirit can be called Children of God.

You will see in this study that I do mention Christian and Children of God - there is a difference. Yes our faith is the world called Christianity but not all Christians are Children of God.

To be a child of God is to be born-again, baptized in water, baptized by the Holy Spirit, to be constantly re filled with the Holy Spirit, bear the fruits of the Spirit, use and give you gift to others and most important to be led by the Holy Spirit.

Only a small percentage of Christians are real Children of God.

Sometimes Christians have to go back to the drawing board and see what steps He or she missed or not perfected.

Maybe they did not receive the baptism of the Holy Spirit or maybe not receive regular re filling of the Holy Spirit and fire called children of God that lost the fire.

We need to step back and return to the Holy Spirit

Heb 5:12 For when for the time ye ought to be teachers, ye have need that one teach you again which *be* the first principles of the oracles of God; and are become such as have need of milk, and not of strong meat.

Heb 6:4 For *it is* impossible for those who were once enlightened, and have tasted of the heavenly gift, and were made partakers of the Holy Ghost,

Heb 6:5 And have tasted the good word of God, and the powers of the world to come,

Heb 6:6 If they shall fall away, to renew them again unto repentance; seeing they crucify to themselves the Son of God afresh, and put *him* to an open shame.

States that we need to use the gift of the Holy Spirit gave us to become interacted with the Spirit of God then it will be dedicate to turn back to sin or even STOP to sin at all.

The Holy Spirit will lead you away from sin.

Heb 12:1 Wherefore seeing we also are compassed about with so great a cloud of witnesses, let us lay aside every weight, and the sin which doth so easily beset *us*, and let us run with patience the race that is set before us,

Heb 12:2 Looking unto Jesus the author and finisher of *our* faith; who for the joy that was set before him endured the cross, despising the shame, and is set down at the right hand of the throne of God.

Heb 12:3 For consider him that endured such contradiction of sinners against himself, lest ye be wearied and faint in your minds.

Heb 12:4 Ye have not yet resisted unto blood, striving against sin.

Heb 12:5 And ye have forgotten the exhortation which speaketh unto you as unto children, My son, despise not thou the chastening of the Lord, nor faint when thou art rebuked of him:

Heb 12:6 For whom the Lord loveth he chasteneth, and scourgeth every son whom he receiveth.

Heb 12:7 If ye endure chastening, God dealeth with you as with sons; for what son is he whom the father chasteneth not?

Heb 12:8 But if ye be without chastisement, whereof all are partakers, then are ye bastards, and not sons.

Heb 12:9 Furthermore we have had fathers of our flesh which corrected *us*, and we gave *them* reverence: shall we not much rather be in subjection unto the Father of spirits, and live?

Heb 12:10 For they verily for a few days chastened *us* after their own pleasure; but he for *our* profit, that *we* might be partakers of his holiness.

Heb 12:11 Now no chastening for the present seemeth to be joyous, but grievous: nevertheless afterward it yieldeth the peaceable fruit of righteousness unto them which are exercised thereby.

Heb 12:12 Wherefore lift up the hands which hang down, and the feeble knees;

Heb 12:13 And make straight paths for your feet, lest that which is lame be turned out of the way; but let it rather be healed.

Move with the Holy Spirit and allow the Holy Spirit to lead you to Spiritual discipline to be become a citizen of Heaven following the rules and regulations of the constitution of the Kingdom of God.

Kingdom Discipline then later turns to spiritual freedom=free of sin.

The Holy Spirit will lead you to freedom-free from the sinful world.

Moses was a great example of sensitive for the voice of God and his weakness allowed him to enter into the great presence of the almighty God to actually talk to God like an old friend

Num 12:3 (Now the man Moses *was* very meek, above all the men which *were* upon the face of the earth.)

Again we see that a soft spirit is the 1st entry point to be led by the Holy Spirit and only after this we will be able to enter the Glorious Presence of God.

Paul begs with us. Please give your live to the Holy Spirit and let the Holy Spirit lead you.

Be available and open for the Holy Spirit offer your spirit to the Holy Spirit

Rom 12:1 I beseech you therefore, brethren, by the mercies of God, that ye present your bodies a living sacrifice, holy, acceptable unto God, *which is your reasonable service.*

In my personnel experience, I several times saw that the baptism of the Holy Spirit - Gods Spirit is a Soft end tender Spirit and will never force it on us as Christians; he will wait patiently for you're to invite him into your life.

Invite the Holy Spirit to enter your spirit and allow the Holy Spirit to change your direction in life be EXTREAMLEY sensitive to the voice of the Spirit, be super sensitive for the comfort, boost fullness.

If we have the Holy Spirit in our lives then we are totally with God AND Jesus when we received the baptism or even re fillings.

We will be dead for sin: every time you receive a filling of the gentle Spirit a fruit becomes stronger and even more gifts becomes present in your live.

We will sin less and less, and eventually become like Jesus until the Holy Spirit is fully happy with us and places the seal of God on our forehead ""Without sin""

Rom 8:9 But ye are not in the flesh, but in the Spirit, if so be that the Spirit of God dwell in you. Now if any man have not the Spirit of Christ, he is none of his.

Rom 8:10 And if Christ *be* in you, the body is dead because of sin; but the Spirit is life because of righteousness.

Rom 8:11 But if the Spirit of him that raised up Jesus from the dead dwell in you, he that raised up Christ from the dead shall also quicken your mortal bodies by his Spirit that dwelleth in you.

Rom 8:12 Therefore, brethren, we are debtors, not to the flesh, to live after the flesh.

Rom 8:13 For if ye live after the flesh, ye shall die: but if ye through the Spirit do mortify the deeds of the body, ye shall live.

Rom 8:14 For as many as are led by the Spirit of God, they are the sons of God.

Rom 8:15 For ye have not received the spirit of bondage again to fear; but ye have received the Spirit of adoption, whereby we cry, Abba, Father.

Rom 8:16 The Spirit itself beareth witness with our spirit, that we are the children of God:

Rom 8:17 And if children, then heirs; heirs of God, and joint-heirs with Christ; if so be that we suffer with *him*, that we may be also glorified together.

In my personal experience every time I received an infilling of the Holy Spirit, MY BEHAVIOR changed according to (Gal 5 v 22 - 23) I become stronger and other move difficult fruit appeared in my life. This is why we as Children of God have to pray for the re filling of the Holy Spirit in our Spirit. Pray for the Baptism of more the 7 Spirits of God in our Spirit.

Every time I received another filling more sin disappeared in my life, and more fruit become stronger and I even received more gifts to help me with my ministry.

But if we don't receive regular fillings of the Holy Spirit the fire will go out, because no oil is added and sin will win.

The day I was baptized by the Holy Spirit, I was on top of the world with a heart full of love, Joy and peace but fruits like patience and self-control were still vague in my life. But every time I received a filling of the Holy Spirit oil, the fruits all of them become stronger and my appetite for sin went away.

Yes: sin is still there, this is the reason I requests a refilling regularly to eventually be full of the Spirit and power to finally be sealed for eternity.

Full me up Holy Spirit until I need no more full me up with love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness and self-control.

Keep my lamp full with oil=Holy Spirit.

Without the meekness of the Holy Spirit there is no discipline and without discipline there will be no freedom to sin.

And without the Holy Spirit in my life, sin will stay in me - because our human nature is to be sinful

Rom 7:18 For I know that in me (that is, in my flesh,) dwelleth no good thing: for to will is present with me; but *how* to perform that which is good I find not.

Rom 7:19 For the good that I would I do not: but the evil which I would not, that I do.

Rom 7:20 Now if I do that I would not, it is no more I that do it, but sin that dwelleth in me.

Rom 7:21 I find then a law, that, when I would do good, evil is present with me.

Rom 7:22 For I delight in the law of God after the inward man:

Rom 7:23 But I see another law in my members, warring against the law of my mind, and bringing me into captivity to the law of sin which is in my members.

God's Spirit: The Holy Spirit is extremely important for us to enter the Kingdom of Heaven.

And when you did receive the Baptism you have to receive regular fillings to become more with the Holy Spirit and even still get the seal of approval from the Holy Spirit to allow you to enter the Kingdom of Heaven.

Rom 8:11 But if the Spirit of him that raised up Jesus from the dead dwell in you, he that raised up Christ from the dead shall also quicken your mortal bodies by his Spirit that dwelleth in you.

Remember that the gifts of the Spirit are there to be used to be given as gifts. The more you give the more you will receive to give away (1 Cor 12)

Do the works of the Holy Spirit, Comfort, boost and lift other children of God lives and listen sensitively to the leading voice of the comforter God has sent to us request of Jesus.

Chapter 5: Kingdom Desires:

Mat 5:6 Blessed *are* they which do hunger and thirst after righteousness: for they shall be filled.

What absolute peace for the Child of God that is hunger for the baptism and refilling of the Holy Spirit that burns of trust for living water and hungry and thirsty for righteousness.

Again we see peace-freedom of sin and calmness that we receive from the Holy Spirit.

We see that righteousness comes from being free of sin and this is sealed by God's spirit baptism in the Holy Spirit and regular fillings of his oil adding the other 7 Spirits of God into our lives.

Our Desires becomes to be with the Holy Spirit in our Spirit and our desires builds out to receiving the fullness of all fruits of the Spirit. Visible in our lives and our desires speaks when we receive our gifts from God's spirits.

When we receive the gifts from God's Spirits.

When we receive the Gifts for example extreme faith then only we will relay the eternal live is close.

Rom 10:3 For they being ignorant of God's righteousness, and going about to establish their own righteousness, have not submitted themselves unto the righteousness of God.

Faith is needed for righteousness when we receive the gift of extreme faith well being fully righteous in God

Php 3:8 Yea doubtless, and I count all things *but* loss for the excellency of the knowledge of Christ Jesus my Lord: for whom I have suffered the loss of all things, and do count them *but* dung, that I may win Christ,

Php 3:9 And be found in him, not having mine own righteousness, which is of the law, but that which is through the faith of Christ, the righteousness which is of God by faith:

Without faith a child of God cannot receive righteousness because if you live in sin you will never have righteousness

Rom 3:10 As it is written, There is none righteous, no, not one:

Rom 3:11 There is none that understandeth, there is none that seeketh after God.

Rom 3:12 They are all gone out of the way, they are together become unprofitable; there is none that doeth good, no, not one.

Rom 3:13 Their throat is an open sepulchre; with their tongues they have used deceit; the poison of asps is under their lips:

Rom 3:14 Whose mouth is full of cursing and bitterness:

Rom 3:15 Their feet *are* swift to shed blood:

Rom 3:16 Destruction and misery *are* in their ways:

Rom 3:17 And the way of peace have they not known:

Rom 3:18 There is no fear of God before their eyes.

Rom 3:19 Now we know that what things soever the law saith, it saith to them who are under the law: that every mouth may be stopped, and all the world may become guilty before God.

Rom 3:20 Therefore by the deeds of the law there shall no flesh be justified in his sight: for by the law is the knowledge of sin.

Rom 3:21 But now the righteousness of God without the law is manifested, being witnessed by the law and the prophets;

Rom 3:22 Even the righteousness of God *which* is by faith of Jesus Christ unto all and upon all them that believe: for there is no difference:

Faith from the Holy Spirit gives you Righteousness and hunger and thirst for the baptism and regular filling of the Holy Spirit allow us to receive the extreme gift of faith that gives ultimate Righteousness.

I can stop this Chapter here, because the message has being delivered. But here more verses from the bible to confirm this chapter.

Kingdom Desires are Righteousness and without Righteousness you will not enter the Kingdom of Heaven.

Mat 5:20 For I say unto you, That except your righteousness shall exceed *the righteousness* of the scribes and Pharisees, ye shall in no case enter into the kingdom of heaven.

Mat 5:21 Ye have heard that it was said by them of old time, Thou shalt not kill; and whosoever shall kill shall be in danger of the judgment:

Mat 5:22 But I say unto you, That whosoever is angry with his brother without a cause shall be in danger of the judgment: and whosoever shall say to his brother,

Raca, shall be in danger of the council: but whosoever shall say, Thou fool, shall be in danger of hell fire.

Mat 5:23 Therefore if thou bring thy gift to the altar, and there rememberest that thy brother hath ought against thee;

Mat 5:24 Leave there thy gift before the altar, and go thy way; first be reconciled to thy brother, and then come and offer thy gift.

Mat 5:25 Agree with thine adversary quickly, whiles thou art in the way with him; lest at any time the adversary deliver thee to the judge, and the judge deliver thee to the officer, and thou be cast into prison.

Mat 5:26 Verily I say unto thee, Thou shalt by no means come out thence, till thou hast paid the uttermost farthing.

Mat 5:27 Ye have heard that it was said by them of old time, Thou shalt not commit adultery:

Mat 5:28 But I say unto you, That whosoever looketh on a woman to lust after her hath committed adultery with her already in his heart.

Jesus crucifixion and Rising from death board our righteous. By requesting Jesus into our lives and turning away from sin brings us in the right path for righteous

Rom 5:17 For if by one man's offence death reigned by one; much more they which receive abundance of grace and of the gift of righteousness shall reign in life by one, Jesus Christ.)

When you turn away from sin, you are then open for the Baptism of the Holy Spirit.

Rom 6:17 But God be thanked, that ye were the servants of sin, but ye have obeyed from the heart that form of doctrine which was delivered you.

Rom 6:18 Being then made free from sin, ye became the servants of righteousness.

Let's look at our *Divine Example* - **Jesus :**

Jesus say's if you do things the smallest in the Kingdom, you do against him.

Mat 25:37 Then shall the righteous answer him, saying, Lord, when saw we thee an hungred, and fed *thee*? or thirsty, and gave *thee* drink?

Mat 25:38 When saw we thee a stranger, and took *thee* in? or naked, and clothed *thee*?

Mat 25:39 Or when saw we thee sick, or in prison, and came unto thee?

Mat 25:40 And the King shall answer and say unto them, Verily I say unto you, Inasmuch as ye have done *it* unto one of the least of these my brethren, ye have done *it* unto me.

Mat 25:41 Then shall he say also unto them on the left hand, Depart from me, ye cursed, into everlasting fire, prepared for the devil and his angels:

Mat 25:42 For I was an hungred, and ye gave me no meat: I was thirsty, and ye gave me no drink:

Mat 25:43 I was a stranger, and ye took me not in: naked, and ye clothed me not: sick, and in prison, and ye visited me not.

Mat 25:44 Then shall they also answer him, saying, Lord, when saw we thee an hungred, or athirst, or a stranger, or naked, or sick, or in prison, and did not minister unto thee?

Mat 25:45 Then shall he answer them, saying, Verily I say unto you, Inasmuch as ye did *it* not to one of the least of these, ye did *it* not to me.

Mat 25:46 And these shall go away into everlasting punishment: but the righteous into life eternal.

Jesus say's Confess each other your sins and pray for the other.

Jas 5:16 Confess *your* faults one to another, and pray one for another, that ye may be healed. The effectual fervent prayer of a righteous man availeth much.

Jesus say's teach other to follow Jesus and the Holy Spirit.

Tit 2:1 But speak thou the things which become sound doctrine:

Tit 2:2 That the aged men be sober, grave, temperate, sound in faith, in charity, in patience.

Put on the Armour of God daily to avoid strikes from our enemy.

The Holy Spirit is the only one that can fill you with Righteous and we need to pray for this.

Php 1:11 Being filled with the fruits of righteousness, which are by Jesus Christ, unto the glory and praise of God.

As a Child of God we should stay away from sin. Isolate our self within the Holy Spirit.

1Ti 6:11 But thou, O man of God, flee these things; and follow after righteousness, godliness, faith, love, patience, meekness.

Citizenship too Heaven's is only available from the Holy Spirit and citizenship of Heaven has to have righteousness, peace and joy from the Holy Spirit.

Rom 14:7 For none of us liveth to himself, and no man dieth to himself.

God's name is righteousness.

Jer 23:6 In his days Judah shall be saved, and Israel shall dwell safely: and this is his name whereby he shall be called, THE LORD OUR RIGHTEOUSNESS.

Righteousness comes from God, to us by the Holy Spirit and confirmed by Jesus.

Your name should change to "A child of God living in Righteousness"

1Jn 2:1 My little children, these things write I unto you, that ye sin not. And if any man sin, we have an advocate with the Father, Jesus Christ the righteous:

Jesus is Righteous.

Closing:

Let's make it easy for our self's. The baptism of the Holy Spirit and continues RE filling with oil=Holy Spirit will bring Righteousness.

Our road to Heaven will be easier if you are led by the Holy Spirit.

The fruits of the spirit have to be fully in your live always (Gal 5 v 22- 23) Bear the fruit that lifts your salvation and Righteous.

Chapter 6: Kingdom Method:

Mat 5:7 Blessed are the merciful: for they shall obtain mercy.

God insures Joy to those that are led by the Holy Spirit. If they become personal involved in other peoples pain, sadness and fear's, this fellowship spreads to prayer and internship with the Spirit, for the Spirit brings care and assurance from God.

Mercy – all of us understand, but there is only a small percentage of Christian's that RECEIVES this..

This means to get involved in a personal level with other Christians problems, pain and suffering. Yes kindness, mercy, does not ONLY stops with a kind word or help here and there, no it means to become part of the solution. Be with the Brother and Sister until God's answered, provides OR supplies.

Luke 18: Praying without stopping until an answer is received by God in healing, deliverance and more.

For those Children of God that is baptized in the Holy Spirit, answers is given by the ability to pray in tongues - this meaning that the Holy Spirit itself takes over in prayer, without interference from the lord of lies or the will of man.

Due to spiritual warfare, sometimes prayer to God takes a bit longer - this is why Jesus says -Pray without giving up.

Prayers via the Holy Spirit are naturally the 1st prize to receive absolute best response from Heaven.

Jesus says if we pray in his name an answer will be given.

Jas 5:5 Ye have lived in pleasure on the earth, and been wanton; ye have nourished your hearts, as in a day of slaughter.

God will react soonest when prayer comes in the name of Jesus and comes via the Holy Spirit

Rom 8:26 Likewise the Spirit also helpeth our infirmities: for we know not what we should pray for as we ought: but the Spirit itself maketh intercession for us with groanings which cannot be uttered.

Rom 8:27 And he that searcheth the hearts knoweth what is the mind of the Spirit, because he maketh intercession for the saints according to *the will of God*.

Prayer via the Holy Spirit is powerful - but remembers this prayer will come from your heart according to Paul

Rom 9:1 I say the truth in Christ, I lie not, my conscience also bearing me witness in the Holy Ghost,

Rom 9:2 That I have great heaviness and continual sorrow in my heart.

Rom 9:3 For I could wish that myself were accursed from Christ for my brethren, my kinsmen according to the flesh:

Rom 9:4 Who are Israelites; to whom *pertaineth* the adoption, and the glory, and the covenants, and the giving of the law, and the service of *God*, and the promises;

Rom 9:5 Whose *are* the fathers, and of whom as concerning the flesh Christ *came*, who is over all, God blessed for ever. Amen.

Rom 9:6 Not as though the word of God hath taken none effect. For they *are* not all Israel, which are of Israel:

Rom 9:7 Neither, because they are the seed of Abraham, *are they* all children: but, In Isaac shall thy seed be called.

Rom 9:8 That is, They which are the children of the flesh, these *are* not the children of God: but the children of the promise are counted for the seed.

Rom 9:9 For this *is* the word of promise, At this time will I come, and Sara shall have a son.

Rom 9:10 And not only *this*; but when Rebecca also had conceived by one, *even* by our father Isaac;

Rom 9:11 (For *the children* being not yet born, neither having done any good or evil, that the purpose of God according to election might stand, not of works, but of him that calleth;)

Rom 9:12 It was said unto her, The elder shall serve the younger.

Rom 9:13 As it is written, Jacob have I loved, but Esau have I hated.

Prayer, faith and forgiveness go hand in hand - pray with faith after forgiveness given.

1Co 4:11 Even unto this present hour we both hunger, and thirst, and are naked, and are buffeted, and have no certain dwellingplace;

1Co 4:12 And labour, working with our own hands: being reviled, we bless; being persecuted, we suffer it:

The Holy Spirits tasks are

- 1: Here to lead us to eternal life.
- 2: For comforting.
- 3: To prepare us for the Kingdom.
- 4: To stand in for us, when we are too weak to do it our self.
- 5: To seal us with the seal of God.

Heb 7:25 Wherefore he is able also to save them to the uttermost that come unto God by him, seeing he ever liveth to make intercession for them.

Thank you Holy Spirit for your tenderness, your desire power, your comfort, your motivation, you're upliftment, your leadership and intersession too God.

As spirited filled Children of God we need to do the same.

Follow the example of the Spirit within us = the Spirit of God = The Holy Spirit.

But as we know the fight is not in this world but in the spirit world.

2Co 10:4 (For the weapons of our warfare *are* not carnal, but mighty through God to the pulling down of strong holds;)

Let's fight this fight with the king, God almighty and the Holy Spirit within us. We have to become like Jesus and the Holy Spirit to be able to enter the Kingdom of Heaven.

Comfort, motivate, and uplift your fellow Christians.

Thank Jesus for praying the father, for he has given us the Comforter to live within us.

Chapter 7: Kingdom Motivation:

Mat 5:8 Blessed *are* the pure in heart: for they shall see God.

Blessed is the person that is washed by the blood of the lamb, without pride, and clean of all sin, so that they can be lead and controlled and at the end, motivated by the Holy Spirit for citizenship in the Kingdom of God.

I see unmixed motives that come with a pure heart.

Jesus's blood cleansed us from all sin, washed whiter than snow according to

Rev 7:9 After this I beheld, and, lo, a great multitude, which no man could number, of all nations, and kindreds, and people, and tongues, stood before the throne, and before the Lamb, clothed with white robes, and palms in their hands;

Rev 7:13 And one of the elders answered, saying unto me, What are these which are arrayed in white robes? and whence came they?

Rev 7:14 And I said unto him, Sir, thou knowest. And he said to me, These are they which came out of great tribulation, and have washed their robes, and made them white in the blood of the Lamb.

Please note: That the Holy Spirit wants a clean your heart to enter - the Baptism of the Holy Spirit will take place if there is NO sin present and also if there is NO un-forgiveness present in your life.

I saw this during my ministry that the Holy Spirit only Baptiste people with a pure HEART.

I always explain this to the person that desires the Baptism of the Holy Spirit.

Your spirit is like a glass (Crystal glass) when you have sin in your life this glass is full of Mud and sin, full of sin with this glass full of mud the Holy Spirit will not pore it precious oil into the glass : it have to be sparkling clean.

Your glass has to be emptied and cleaned. By the Blood of Jesus!
Who else will do this job too perfection?

Jesus's blood will wash this glass sparkling clean and only when it clean the Holy Spirit will enter and here it comes - it needs to remain clean for the Spirit to stay there.

This glass have to be kept clean and filled with the Holy Spirits oil to enter Heaven = **for no sin will enter the Holiness of Heaven.**

If this glass is clean then the Baptism of the Holy Spirit will take place.

Yes: some Christians do get this muddy glass emptied and cleaned with the assistance of Jesus.

But it has to remain empty from sin to continue Baptism.

This Glass cannot stay empty after cleaning - To keep the glass empty is very dangerous.

In the old Pentecostal days this was the norm: when a person received Jesus and he or she became born again, this new born was kept at church for a period of 7 days.

In these 7 days the invitation for the Holy Spirit to enter this new soul was prayed for.

This new soul was not to leave the church until baptism of the Holy Spirit had taken place.

Even if it was requested - to take off work for a week.

This was very important for the early church that everybody is sure that this new born was baptized by the Holy Spirit.

The baptism of the Holy Spirit was a form of protection.

They knew that the Holy Spirit will be part of this new soul's life to lead him or her to Heaven.

After baptism, the person was allowed to continue his or her normal life.

In today's churches new Born are left for the wolf's to fend for themselves.

We don't take that extra mile with our new born anymore, but then we want to be judgmental when they fall back into sin.

My prayer for new Born is that the right well equipped disciple leads him or her to Jesus.

And takes him or her via the steps leading to eternal life.

Let everybody walk in the light

1Jn 1:7 But if we walk in the light, as he is in the light, we have fellowship one with another, and the blood of Jesus Christ his Son cleanseth us from all sin.

Yes your glass (soul)(spirit) is extremely clean when Jesus washes it

Joh 15:3 Now ye are clean through the word which I have spoken unto you.

In the days we live in, new born again christens is left to fend for themselves. Jesus then places the desires into their heart to study the word of God, for to get the right teaching from the bible.

Psa 119:9 BETH. Wherewithal shall a young man cleanse his way? by taking heed *thereto* according to thy word.

The Psalmist states how will the new born keep his soul clean. To keep it filled with the word of God until the baptism of the Holy Spirit can take place.

But it's a difficult task to keep the glass clean and keep your glass clean.

2 Cor 7:1 Having therefore these promises, dearly beloved, let us cleanse ourselves from all filthiness of the flesh and spirit, perfecting holiness in the fear of God.

(Gal 5 v 19-21) Fruits of the Spirit

Run the race until the winning pole = the Baptism of the Holy Spirit

Heb 12:1 Wherefore seeing we also are compassed about with so great a cloud of witnesses, let us lay aside every weight, and the sin which doth so easily beset us, and let us run with patience the race that is set before us,

Clean your heart

Jas 4:8 Draw nigh to God, and he will draw nigh to you. Cleanse *your* hands, *ye* sinners; and purify *your* hearts, *ye* double minded.

Clean it from sin

Heb 12:1 Wherefore seeing we also are compassed about with so great a cloud of witnesses, let us lay aside every weight, and the sin which doth so easily beset *us*, and let us run with patience the race that is set before us,

The Holy Spirit will lead you to clean your glass.
He wants to be part of you.

According to **1 Per 1:22** Seeing ye have purified your souls in obeying the truth through the Spirit unto unfeigned love of the brethren, *see that ye love one another with a pure heart fervently:*

He wants to be with you, in you and part of you.

Some more verses to confirm this:

Heb 9:14 How much more shall the blood of Christ, who through the eternal Spirit offered himself without spot to God, purge your conscience from dead works to serve the living God?

Jesus blood cleans us from sin.

Jer 17:9 The heart *is* deceitful above all *things*, and desperately wicked: who can know it?

Our human nature is sinful.

Mat 15:19 For out of the heart proceed evil thoughts, murders, adulteries, fornications, thefts, false witness, blasphemies:

Mat 15:20 These are *the things* which defile a man: but to eat with unwashen hands defileth not a man.

The soul of man is naturally sinful.

Heb 4:12 For the word of God *is* quick, and powerful, and sharper than any twoedged sword, piercing even to the dividing asunder of soul and spirit, and of the joints and marrow, and *is* a discerner of the thoughts and intents of the heart.

God word speaks to the heart to get it cleaned.

Php 4:18 But I have all, and abound: I am full, having received of Epaphroditus the things *which were sent* from you, an odour of a sweet smell, a sacrifice acceptable, well pleasing to God.

Php 4:19 But my God shall supply all your need according to his riches in glory by Christ Jesus.

A pure heart is like incense to God.

“A Pure Heart”

We see that a pure heart in the kingdom has absolute power with unmixed emotion.

Let your yes, be your yes. Your no , you're NO, and you will be led by the Holy Spirit in everything you do and you are motivated to miss the judgment day and enter the Kingdom of Heaven.

We are Spirit filled children of God and we will be with God someday, what a promise.

To walk in the light - Jesus. = Jesus is the light

1Ti 6:15 Which in his times he shall shew, *who is* the blessed and only Potentate, the King of kings, and Lord of lords;

1Ti 6:16 Who only hath immortality, dwelling in the light which no man can approach unto; whom no man hath seen, nor can see: to whom *be* honour and power everlasting. Amen.

Psa 16:11 Thou wilt shew me the path of life: in thy presence *is* fulness of joy; at thy right hand *there are* pleasures for evermore.

In Heaven we will understand everything.

1Co 13:12 For now we see through a glass, darkly; but then face to face: now I know in part; but then shall I know even as also I am known.

Jesus himself will teach this.

1Ti 6:17 Charge them that are rich in this world, that they be not highminded, nor trust in uncertain riches, but in the living God, who giveth us richly all things to enjoy;

God will provide everything.
God will give you what you need.

God will heal your sickness.
Jesus is our shepherd.

God gives peace.
God gives righteousness.

God is our future.
God is our protection.

It's important that we know and understand the names of the Lord.
Memorize them for future use.

Jehovah Jireh- the Lord who sees/supplies

Gen 22:14 And Abraham called the name of that place Jehovah jireh: as it is said to this day, In the mount of the LORD it shall be seen.

Jehovah Rah- The Lord my Shepherd

Psa 23:1 A Psalm of David. The LORD is my shepherd; I shall not want.

Jehovah Shalom- The Lord my Peace

Jdg 6:24 Then Gideon built an altar there unto the LORD, and called it Jehovah shalom: unto this day it is yet in Ophrah of the Abiezrites.

Jehovah Rapha- the Lord my healer

Exo 15:26 And said, If thou wilt diligently hearken to the voice of the LORD thy God, and wilt do that which is right in his sight, and wilt give ear to his commandments, and keep all his statutes, I will put none of these diseases upon thee, which I have brought upon the Egyptians: for I *am* the LORD that healeth thee.

Jehovah - The Lord my righteousness.

Jehovah Shammah - The Lord is present

Eze 48:35 It was round about eighteen thousand measures: and the name of the city from that day shall be, The LORD is there.

Jehovah Nissi-The Lord my protection

Psa 24:10 Who is this King of glory? The LORD of hosts, he is the King of glory. Selah.

For they will have a progressive fellowship and revelation of God resulting in a comprehensive knowledge and appreciation of God his ways, his desires and his program for the kingdom.

Ultimately they will dwell eternally in his glorious presence

Mat 6:33 But seek ye first the kingdom of God, and his righteousness; and all these things shall be added unto you.

Create in me a pure heart O Lord, this should be our prayer.

We can be led by the Holy Spirit to understand the word of God and unmixed emotions.

Become a citizen of Heaven.

When we are ready, to be sealed by the Holy Spirit for eternal life.

Lord I will seek the Kingdom of Heaven and Righteousness and the Holy Spirit then God will provide the rest.

My Prayer:

Thank you my Lord for your provider, Your Sheppard role, your healing of mind and body, your peace, your righteousness, your presence and your protection.

We praise and exalt thee O Lord, for you loved us FIRST.

Live in me, lead me Holy Spirit, God I thank you for sending your Son to die on the cross for my sins.

Create in me a pure heart O Lord. Amen and Amen.

Chapter 8: Kingdom Work Ethic:

Mat 5:9. Blessed are the peacemakers: for they shall be called the children of God.

Blessed are those that bring peace between the man and God, and those that were led by the Holy Spirit who endures with Jesus, and those who bring the good news to God's people.

They are called peace makers, they are Children of God, and they are equipped on trained for citizenship of Heaven, trained and equipped by the Holy Spirit. The Kingdom of God belongs to THEM.

The work Ethic of Heaven is peace: naturally humans are sinful and without God being without God is being without peace.

Peace is also NR 3 on the list of fruits of the Spirit according to (Gal 5 v 22)

Spirit filled children of God can only have this title if they have peace and become peacemakers.

Isa 48:22 There is no peace, saith the LORD, unto the wicked.

This is not peace between the world and Children of God.
Jesus says he did not come to create peace.

The sinful world and Christians.

He comes to create difference between bad and good

Mat 10:34 Think not that I am come to send peace on earth: I came not to send peace, but a sword.

Mat 10:35 For I am come to set a man at variance against his father, and the daughter against her mother, and the daughter in law against her mother in law.

Mat 10:36 And a man's foes shall be they of his own household.

Jesus also said that he come to great peace between man and God

Mat 10:37 He that loveth father or mother more than me is not worthy of me: and he that loveth son or daughter more than me is not worthy of me.

There will always be words and a problem between Children of the light and Children of the darkness.

God always wanted peace on Earth, this is well known.
God sends his angels to Earth.
They always greet with the words peace to everybody on Earth.
God is God of peace and his Spirit is peace

Luk 2:14 Glory to God in the highest, and on earth peace, good will toward men.

But remember our enemy is the Lord of anger and fighting. Remember our fight is spiritual one. = The warfare is with Satan

Eph 6:12 For we wrestle not against flesh and blood, but against principalities, against powers, against the rulers of the darkness of this world, against spiritual wickedness in high *places*.

Remember with the Holy Spirit on your side you are more than a VICTOR.

Jesus came to bring peace between man and God and when we accept discipleship with Jesus we agree to take on our Cross and follow him. We become peacemakers, peacemaker between man and man, man and Jesus and man and God.

Not to replace Jesus - no but when we become his disciples we need to introduce the sinner to Jesus: When the sinner becomes born again he receives peace and peace is created between man and Jesus.

Jesus states - come to me so we can make peace; we need to work to total peace, reconciliation and peace making

2Co 5:17 Therefore if any man *be* in Christ, *he is* a new creature: old things are passed away; behold, all things are become new.

2Co 5:18 And all things *are* of God, who hath reconciled us to himself by Jesus Christ, and hath given to us the ministry of reconciliation;

2Co 5:19 To wit, that God was in Christ, reconciling the world unto himself, not imputing their trespasses unto them; and hath committed unto us the word of reconciliation.

2Co 5:20 Now then we are ambassadors for Christ, as though God did beseech *you* by us: we pray *you* in Christ's stead, be ye reconciled to God.

Peace comes when sin run's away.

Peace comes when we follow God's law as recorded in (Ex 20)

Peace comes when we follow Jesus law of love.

Peace comes when we follow and implement what the bible tells us.

Peace comes when we follow Jesus as example the Psalmist States no peace with sin

Psa 119:165 Great peace have they which love thy law: and nothing shall offend them.

We as Children of God have to divine task to bring peace, reconciliation and inner peace according

Isa 32:17 And the work of righteousness shall be peace; and the effect of righteousness quietness and assurance for ever.

Isa 32:18 And my people shall dwell in a peaceable habitation, and in sure dwellings, and in quiet resting places;

There will be safety when peace is created between men and between man and Jesus, and man and God. Great peace comes with the Baptism of the Holy Spirit.

If we don't have peace now, we will suffer when the end of times happen or take place.

Peace brings safety. Safety brings peace.

Peace is the norm if we are in the safety of God.

Jesus says in the last days. People will die of heart failure due to fear

Luke 21:26. Men's hearts failing them for fear, and for looking after those things which are coming on the earth: for the powers of heaven shall be shaken.

Without the seal of God we will be doomed for eternal punishment without the seal of Satan we all be allowed to enter Heaven.

We are so blessed, thank you Jesus for praying to God, requesting him to send the comforter the Holy Spirit.

Without the Holy Spirit peace and leadership we will be lost

Joh 14:1 Let not your heart be troubled: ye believe in God, believe also in me.

Joh 14:6 Jesus saith unto him, I am the way, the truth, and the life: no man cometh unto the Father, but by me.

Rom 8:6 For to be carnally minded is death; but to be spiritually minded is life and peace.

Rom 8:14 For as many as are led by the Spirit of God, they are the sons of God.

Peace makers are called Children of God.

Christians that is led by the Spirit is called Children of God.

Pray with the new born for the Baptism of the Holy Spirit

Mat 28:19 Go ye therefore, and teach all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Ghost:

Mat 28:20 Teaching them to observe all things whatsoever I have commanded you: and, lo, I am with you alway, *even* unto the end of the world. Amen.

Jesus came to Earth to bring peace between God and man. If you accepted Jesus as your saviour, Jesus prayed the father to send the Holy Spirit and that we can be baptized in the Holy Spirit and with the Holy Spirit in us we have to act as peacemakers

Joh 6:38 For I came down from heaven, not to do mine own will, but the will of him that sent me.
confirms.

Chapter 9: Kingdom Identification:

Mat 5:10 Blessed are they which are persecuted for righteousness' sake: for theirs is the kingdom of heaven.

Mat 5:11 Blessed are ye, when men shall revile you, and persecute you, and shall say all manner of evil against you falsely, for my sake.

Mat 5:12 Rejoice, and be exceeding glad: for great is your reward in heaven: for so persecuted they the prophets which were before you.

In the Kingdom of Heaven, it's easy to recognize the ones that suffered for Jesus, God and the Holy Spirit they will be identification as the one that is in possession of the keys of Heaven.

The Psalmist warns the Children of God, that the ungodly rules and people will always prosecute, falsely convict or even kill Christians for their faith

Psa 37:32 The wicked watcheth the righteous, and seeketh to slay him.

Month after Jesus Ascended to Heaven. Jesus follower was in Tribulation and killed because they were spreading the good news.

This still happens today, but blessed is the ones who suffer for the name of Jesus.

I'm willing to die for my saviour, because blessed I will be.

Will you die for Jesus? Jesus asked this question will you give your life for somebody.

I do not fear the ungodly. Because the one that is in me is bigger than what is in the world. The Psalmist States I do not fear

Psa 56:5 Every day they wrest my words: all their thoughts are against me for evil.

There will always be conflict between God's people and Satan's people, but they have already lost and know their future is eternal punishment within Hell. Do not fear the enemy = Godless people

Pro 29:27 An unjust man is an abomination to the just: and he that is upright in the way is abomination to the wicked.

It was Apostle Peter that said. It God's grace if somebody is harmed by the Godless people and power to the ones that suffer is the footprints of Jesus.

God thank you for your grace and blessings.
I'm willing to suffer for you

1Pe 2:19 For this is thankworthy, if a man for conscience toward God endure grief, suffering wrongfully.

1Pe 2:20 For what glory is it, if, when ye be buffeted for your faults, ye shall take it patiently? but if, when ye do well, and suffer *for it*, ye take it patiently, this is acceptable with God.

1Pe 2:21 For even hereunto were ye called: because Christ also suffered for us, leaving us an example, that ye should follow his steps:

NOTE- that the end times IT will become worse.

When the mark of the beast of the 666 are implemented.

Where you will be forced to take this to survive and receive medical treatment.

Without this godless mark, you will have no income . THE GOOD NEWS is God will take care of you!

Are you ready for this?

2Th 3:1 Finally, brethren, pray for us, that the word of the Lord may have *free* course, and be glorified, even as *it is* with you:

If you stand for Jesus or follow him you will be protected.

2Th 3:12 Now them that are such we command and exhort by our Lord Jesus Christ, that with quietness they work, and eat their own bread.

Remember in the spiritual world everything is the opposite way. If you are weak, you are actually strong. The ones who suffer are blessed.

God's Spirit will comfort, boost you and lift you up in these days

2 Cor 12:10 Therefore I take pleasure in infirmities, in reproaches, in necessities, in persecutions, in distresses for Christ's sake: for when I am weak, then am I strong.

Remember nothing will divide us from God love and the love of Jesus has for us, not oppression, not fear, not prosecution, not hunger, not danger, not satan himself - nothing.

Remember in all this you are more than a conqueror, a conqueror is someone that already win.

Jesus says we are more than a conqueror.

We are conquerors over and over.

Jesus conquered death. Jesus conquered sin.

Jesus conquered Satan.

Jesus = the King of Kings.

Thee Champions over Champions.

Nothing will separate us from God's love

Rom 8:35 Who shall separate us from the love of Christ? *shall* tribulation, or distress, or persecution, or famine, or nakedness, or peril, or sword?

Rom 8:36 As it is written, For thy sake we are killed all the day long; we are accounted as sheep for the slaughter.

Rom 8:37 Nay, in all these things we are more than conquerors through him that loved us.

Rom 8:38 For I am persuaded, that neither death, nor life, nor angels, nor principalities, nor powers, nor things present, nor things to come,

Rom 8:39 Nor height, nor depth, nor any other creature, shall be able to separate us from the love of God, which is in Christ Jesus our Lord.

Just remember, on your side of this battle

1: God Almighty.

2: Jesus the King of Glory.

3: The Holy Spirit.

4: And 2/3 of the original Angles in Heaven.

Let the battle begin! Are you ready?

For you will own the Kingdom if you suffered, convicted and prosecuted due to the Trinity.

What a promise, sealed for the eternal life.

In a Sinful World as a sinner without God

Every step is of absolute importance and has to be completed and mastered, before moving on to the next step in your spiritual life. Not one step can be shipped or missed or even half-heartedly done. Each step has to be done 100% for you to move to the next in the spirit.

The sadness of all is that only a hand full of Christians will reach the top of the staircase, being Heaven. Or even reach step 10 of this revelation.

A large percentage of Christians will not reach step 11. And some will even falter and fall from the staircase back to the floor.

But if you want to make it to Heaven one day then you need to take every step and master it 100%. And then move on closer and closer to God and Heaven.

This salvation plan is nothing new, but only a replica of the original salvation plan of the Old Testament following the plan of the Tabernacle of God or later the plan of the Temple of God as given to Moses by God.

Let's begin our journey to Heaven.

Everybody starts on the floor: Without God in a sinful World!

Eph 2:12 and that at that time you were without Christ, being aliens from the commonwealth of Israel, and strangers from the covenants of promise, having no hope, and without God in the world. Let's move to Step 1, on the road to Heaven.

Step 1: Admitting you are a sinner.

You need to make this step by yourself, you need to admit that you are a sinner and living in the World without God. And if you continue living like this you will never reach Heaven.

Admitting is step nr 1.

God, I'm a sinner, I do realize that with this sin in my life, I cannot be close to you! And will never receive the gift of Eternal Life.

I know that I need to stop sinning and that I need to ask God forgiveness for my past actions. And need to invite Jesus Christ into my heart to come and clean my mind and spirit of all past sin.

What is sin?

Sin is anything that stands between you and God. With sin in your live, God will not be part of your life.

Yes. God do love you! But He does not like sin and there is no relationship between you and God if you are sinful. You need to repair this relationship.

By taking this step

All people have sinned.

Rom 3:23 for all have sinned and come short of the glory of God, Sin is temptation.

Jas 1:15 Then when lust has conceived, it brings forth sin. And sin, when it is fully formed, brings forth death.

Sin begins in the mind.

Mat 5:27 you have heard that it was said to the ancients, "You shall not commit adultery."

Mat 5:28 But I say to you that whoever looks on a woman to lust after her has already committed adultery with her in his heart.

God have to punish sin.

Ex. 32:34 and now go, lead the people to the place of which I have spoken to you. Behold, My Angel shall go before you. And in the day of my visitation I will visit their sin upon them.

We should humble confess sin.

2Sa 24:10 and David's heart struck him after he had numbered the people. And David said to Jehovah, I have sinned greatly in what I have done. And now, I beseech You, O Jehovah; take away the iniquity of Your servant, for I have done very foolishly.

11 And David rose up in the morning. And the Word of Jehovah came to the prophet Gad, David's seer, saying, 12 Go and say to David, So says Jehovah, I offer you three things. Choose one of them, so that I may do it to you.

13 And Gad came to David, and told him, and said to him, Shall seven years of famine come upon you and on your land? Or will you flee three months before your enemies while they pursue you? Or shall there be three days' plague in your land? And advise, and see what answer I shall return to Him who sent me.

14 And David said to Gad, I am in great distress. Let us fall now into the hand of Jehovah, for His mercies are great. And do not let me fall into the hand of man.

15 And Jehovah sent a plague upon Israel from the morning even till the time appointed. And there died from the people, from Dan to Beersheba, seventy thousand men.

Sin leads to eternal death.

Ezra 9:5 and at the evening sacrifice I rose up from my affliction. And tearing my garment and my mantle, I fell on my knees and spread out my hands to Jehovah my God.

6 And I said, O my God, I am ashamed and blush to lift up my face to You, my God. For our iniquities have increased over our heads, and our guiltiness has grown up to the heavens.

7 Since the days of our fathers we have been in a great sin until this day. And for our iniquities we, our kings, our priests, have been delivered into the hand of the kings of the lands, to the sword, to captivity, and to a spoil, and to shame of face, as it is this day.

8 And now for a little time grace has been shown from Jehovah our God, to leave us a remnant to escape and to give us a nail in His holy place, so that our God may enlighten our eyes and give us a little life in our bondage.

9 For we were slaves, yet our God has not left us in our bondage, but has given mercy to us in the sight of the kings of Persia, to give us some life, to set up the house of our God, and to repair its waste, and to give us a wall in Judah and in Jerusalem.

10 And now, O our God, what shall we say after this? For we have forsaken Your commandments

11 which You commanded by Your servants the prophets, saying, The land into which you go to possess it, is an unclean land with the filthiness of the people of the lands, with their abominations which have filled it from one end to the other

with their uncleanness.

12 And now do not give your daughters to their sons, nor take their daughters to your sons, nor seek their peace or their wealth forever, so that you may be strong and eat the good of the land and leave it for an inheritance to your sons forever.

13 And after all that has come on us for our evil deeds and for our great sin, since You our God have punished us less than our iniquities deserve, and have given us such an escape as this,

14 should we again break Your commandments and join hands with the people of these abominations? Would you not be angry with us until you had crushed us, until there is no remnant nor survivor?

15 O Jehovah, the God of Israel, You are righteous. For we are left a remnant that has escaped, as today. Behold, we are before you in our sins, for we cannot stand before you because of this.

Sin becomes death.

Rom 6:23 for the wages of sin is death, but the gift of God is eternal life through Jesus Christ our Lord.

God will forgive us our sin, if we ask for forgiveness.

1Jn 1:8 If we say that we have no sin, we deceive ourselves and the truth is not in us.

9 If we confess our sins, He is faithful and just to forgive us our sins, and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness.

In sin you are without God.

Eph 2:12 and that at that time you were without Christ, being aliens from the commonwealth of Israel, and strangers from the covenants of promise, having no hope, and without God in the world.

Human's has a sinful nature.

Gen 3:1 now the serpent was more cunning than any beast of the field which Jehovah God had made. And he said to the woman, is it so that God has said, You shall not eat of every tree of the garden?

2 And the woman said to the serpent, we may eat of the fruit of the trees of the garden.

3 But of the fruit of the tree which is in the middle of the garden, God has said, You shall not eat of it, neither shall you touch it, lest you die.

4 And the serpent said to the woman, You shall not surely die,

5 for God knows that in the day you eat of it, then your eyes shall be opened, and

you shall be as God, knowing good and evil.

6 And when the woman saw that the tree was good for food, and that it was pleasing to the eyes, and a tree to be desired to make wise, she took of its fruit, and ate. She also gave to her husband with her, and he ate.

7 And the eyes of both of them were opened. And they knew that they were naked. And they sewed fig leaves together and made girdles for themselves.

8 And they heard the voice of Jehovah God walking in the garden in the cool of the day. And Adam and his wife hid themselves from the presence of Jehovah God in the middle of the trees of the garden.

9 And Jehovah God called to Adam and said to him, where are you?

10 And he said, I heard Your voice in the garden, and I was afraid, because I am naked, and I hid myself.

11 And He said, who told you that you were naked? Have you eaten of the tree which I commanded you that you should not eat?

12 And the man said, the woman whom You gave to be with me, she gave me of the tree, and I ate.

13 And Jehovah God said to the woman, what is this you have done? And the woman said, the serpent deceived me, and I ate.

14 And Jehovah God said to the serpent, because you have done this you are cursed more than all cattle, and more than every animal of the field. You shall go upon your belly, and you shall eat dust all the days of your life.

15 And I will put enmity between you and the woman, and between your seed and her Seed; He will bruise your head, and you shall bruise His heel.

16 To the woman He said, I will greatly increase your sorrow and your conception. In pain you shall bear sons, and your desire shall be toward your husband, and he shall rule over you.

17 And to Adam He said, because you have listened to the voice of your wife and have eaten of the tree, of which I commanded you, saying, You shall not eat of it! The ground is cursed for your sake. In pain shall you eat of it all the days of your life?

18 It shall also bring forth thorns and thistles to you, and you shall eat the herb of the field.

19 in the sweat of your face you shall eat bread until you return to the ground, for out of it you were taken. For dust you are, and to dust you shall return.

God do punish sin.

Ex 32:34 and now go, lead the people to the place of which I have spoken to you. Behold, My Angel shall go before you. And in the day of My visitation I will visit their sin upon them.

God requires a clean heart a pure heart.

Psalm 51:10 Create in me a clean heart, O God, and renew a right Spirit within me.

The Flesh brings Sin; the Spirit brings freedom of sin.

Rom 8:1 there is therefore now no condemnation to those who are in Christ Jesus, who walk not according to the flesh but according to the Spirit.

2 But the Law of the Spirit of life in Christ Jesus has made me free from the law of sin and death.

Step 2: Turning away from sin.

Now that you admitted that you are a sinner to God and yourself, you need to show God your reaction in turning away from sin.

And with this 180 degree turn away from sin, walking in the direction of the Cross. A few steps will be taken in this process,

Accepting Jesus, Forgiveness and then finally washing away all trace of sin from your life the Baptism of Water.

At this time of the road to Heaven, there have to be some emotion in the form of tears and sorrow.

Speak to God in prayer and be censure and open up to God. Admit all your sin to Him, and ask Him to help you with this submission of sin and walking away from it.

With the Tears and sorrow, we call this to be Born Again in the spiritual world. Your mind and spirit is now getting cleaned and released from this bondage of sin.

You will feel a load of your shoulders and feel like a new person.

You will receive a clean page in your live story from God. But you need to change your life style from now on and walking away in to the opposite direction from sin.

At this point you will always hear the voice of the biggest liar – Satan will tell you a list of things to force you not to continue to the next step. Things like: How can you expect God to forgive you for all this horrible things you sinned or you will not be able to walk away from this sin.

Remember God has just wiped your slate clean, and nobody will ever be able to bring this back. He removed this sin from you, as far as the west is from the east. Yes Satan will always remind you of past happenings in your life. All you need to do is remind him of his future. According to Revelations 20, Satan, you will be casted in the pool of fire (Hell) and will be punished until eternity.

Turn away from your past sin and walk towards Jesus Christ, without looking back.

Some examples of sin

The Ten Commandments

Ex. 20:1 and God spoke all these words, saying,

2 I am Jehovah your God, who has brought you out of the land of Egypt, out of the house of bondage.

3 You shall have no other gods before Me.

4 You shall not make to yourselves any graven image, or any likeness of anything that is in the heavens above, or that is in the earth beneath, or that is in the water under the earth.

5 You shall not bow yourself down to them, nor serve them. For I Jehovah your God am a jealous God, visiting the iniquity of the fathers upon the sons to the third and fourth generation of those that hate me,

6 and showing mercy to thousands of those that love Me and keep My commandments.

7 You shall not take the name of Jehovah your God in vain. For Jehovah will not hold him guiltless that takes His name in vain.

8 Remember the Sabbath day, to keep it holy.

9 Six days you shall labor and do all your work.

10 But the seventh day is the Sabbath of Jehovah your God. You shall not do any work, you, or your son, or your daughter, your manservant, or your maidservant, or your cattle, or your stranger within your gates.

11 for in six days Jehovah made the heavens and the earth, the sea, and all that is in them, and rested the seventh day. Therefore Jehovah blessed the Sabbath day, and sanctified it.

12 Honor your father and your mother, so that your days may be long upon the land which Jehovah your God gives you.

13 You shall not kill.

14 You shall not commit adultery.

15 You shall not steal.

16 You shall not bear false witness against your neighbor.

17 You shall not covet your neighbor's house. You shall not covet your neighbor's wife, or his manservant, or his maidservant, or his ox, or his ass, or anything that is your neighbor's.

The Fruits of the flesh = sin.

Gal 5:19 Now the works of the flesh are clearly revealed, which are: adultery, fornication, uncleanness, lustfulness,

20 idolatry, sorcery, hatreds, fightings, jealousies, angers, rivalries, divisions,

heresies,

21 envyings, murders, drunkennesses, revelings, and things like these; of which I tell you before, as I also said before, that they who do such things shall not inherit the kingdom of God.

Step 3: Accepting Jesus as your personal saviour.

At this step – Jesus is awaiting your presence.

At this step you will meet the King of Kings, the Lord of Lords, your Saviour Jesus Christ the Son of the Almighty God. Don't be afraid, He is a God of Love. He will receive you with open arms.

Here, you will acknowledge that Jesus died on the Cross of Gal very for your sin and His body was given for your Healing and His Blood was poured for your salvation. His blood is the cleaning agent to wash your sin away.

At this step you will meet your only true friend. At this step for the rest of the way, you will not walk alone.

Jesus will be walking with you.

God gave His Son Jesus to die on our behalf for our sin.

John 3:16 For God so loved the world that He gave His only-begotten Son, that whoever believes in Him should not perish but have everlasting life.

John 6:35 And Jesus said to them, I am the bread of life. He who comes to Me shall never hunger, and he who believes on Me shall never thirst.

John 10:28 and I give to them eternal life, and they shall never ever perish, and not anyone shall pluck them out of My hand.

John 11:25 Jesus said to her, I am the Resurrection and the Life! He who believes in Me, though he die, yet he shall live.

26 And whoever lives and believes in Me shall never die. Do you believe this?

John 14:6 Jesus said to him, I am the Way, the Truth, and the Life; no one comes to the Father but by Me.

Act 16:31 And they said, Believe on the Lord Jesus Christ and you shall be saved, and your household.

Rom 6:23 For the wages of sin is death, but the gift of God is eternal life through Jesus Christ our Lord.

Step 4: Faith in the Trinity.

At this step, you receive your mustard seed faith, not only believing in Jesus that is now within you, but believing in God and the Holy Spirit that you will meet

personally at step 9 and 12. You need to believe that the Bible is the words of God. And that you are on the way to the Greatest City you have ever seen. You are now very close to the capital of the Kingdom of God. And you are already in the Kingdom of Heaven. Now you will start building on this newly found friendship and faith.

Faith is needed for salvation.

Rom 3:28 Therefore we conclude that a man is justified by faith without the works of the Law.

God is Faith.

Eph 4:5 one Lord, one faith, one baptism, only a small amount of faith is needed.
Luke 17:6 And the Lord said, if you had faith as a grain of mustard seed, you might say to this sycamine tree, be rooted up and be planted in the sea! And it would obey you.

Faith comes from hearing, reading and living the word of God.

Rom 10:17 Then faith is of hearing, and hearing by the Word of God. Faith is hoping in something you cannot see.

Heb 11:1 Now faith is the substance of things hoped for, the evidence of things not seen.

Faith accompanies obedience in God.

Heb 10:7 Then I said, Lo, I come (in the volume of the Book it is written of Me) to do Your will, O God.”

8 Above, when He said, “Sacrifice and offering, and burnt offerings and offering for sin You did not desire, neither did You have pleasure in them” (which are offered according to the Law),

9 then He said, “Lo, I come to do Your will, O God.” He takes away the first so that He may establish the second.

10 By this will we are sanctified through the offering of the body of Jesus Christ once for all.

11 And indeed every priest stands daily ministering and offering often the same sacrifices, which can never take away sins.

12 but this Man, after He had offered one sacrifice for sins forever, sat down on the right of God,

Believing in God takes faith.

Gen 15:6 and he believed in Jehovah. And He counted it to him for righteousness.

Faith places us in the right relationship with God.

Rom 5:1 Therefore being justified by faith, we have peace with God through our Lord Jesus Christ.

Step 5: Giving and Receiving Forgiveness. This is a very important step in any Christian's life for this being the step where a large percentage of Christians gets stuck on their way to Paradise.

This step is extremely important. This is where you have to give and receive forgiveness.

Giving forgiveness, to those that has sinned against you in the past, family members, friends and the enemy. If you do not forgive them, how can you expect God to forgive you? Again this step will be filled with emotion tears and Sorrow. But the load will lift of your shoulders.

If you do not forgive and receive forgiveness you will not be able to move to the next step. Some do move to the next step, but find that they cannot go to step 7 and 8, and they then have to return to step 5 to complete and master fully.

Restoration and healing of relationships is in the order of the day. Go and see, phone and ask forgiveness to fellow Nabors and go to those that sinned against you and give them your forgiveness. You need to clean up, push out all bitterness and forgive, set free and be set free by others. Clean your soul and spirit from un-forgiveness.

Do it and move on!

God forgives many sins.

Psalm 65:3 Things of iniquity are mightier than I; as for our transgressions, you shall purge them away.

God forgives us because He loves us.

Psalm 86:5 For You, Lord, are good and ready to forgive, and rich in mercy to all those who call on You.

The Blood of Jesus washes us cleaner as snow.

Isa 1:18 Come now, and let us reason together, says Jehovah; though your sins are as scarlet, they shall be as white as snow; though they are red like crimson, they shall be like wool.

God will remove our impurities.

Ezekiel 36:25 and I will sprinkle clean waters on you and you shall be clean. I will cleanse you from all your filthiness and from your idols.

We have to forgive others that sin against us.

Mat 6:14 for if you forgive men their trespasses, your heavenly Father will also forgive you;

15 but if you do not forgive men their trespasses, neither will your Father forgive your trespasses.

Don't only forgive once.

Mat 18:21 Then Peter came to Him and said, Lord, how often shall my brother sin against me and I forgive him? Until - seven times?

22 Jesus said to him, I do not say to you, until seven times; but, until seventy times seven.

23 Therefore the kingdom of Heaven has been compared to a certain king who desired to make an accounting with his servants.

24 And when he had begun to count, one was brought to him who owed him ten thousand talents.

25 but as he had nothing to pay, his lord commanded that he, and his wife and children, and all that he had, be sold, and payment be made.

26 Then the servant fell down and worshiped him, saying, Lord, have patience with me and I will pay you all.

27 Then the lord of that servant was moved with compassion and released him and forgave him the debt.

28 But the same servant went out and found one of his fellow servants who owed him a hundred denarii. And he laid hands on him and took him by the throat, saying, Pay me what you owe.

29 And his fellow servant fell down at his feet and begged him, saying, Have patience with me and I will pay you all.

30 And he would not, but went and cast him into prison until he should pay the debt.

31 So when his fellow servants saw what was done, they were very sorry. And they came and told their lord all that was done.

32 Then his lord, after he had called him, said to him, O wicked servant, I forgave you all that debt because you begged me.

33 Should you not also have pitied your fellow servant, even as I had pity on you?

34 And his lord was angry, and delivered him to the tormentors until he should pay all that was due to him.

35 So likewise shall My heavenly Father do also to you, unless each one of you from your hearts forgives his brother their trespasses.

Freely forgive other as God forgave us.

Col 3:13 forbearing one another and forgiving yourselves, if anyone has a complaint against any. As Christ forgave you, so also you do.

God will forgive us our sins.

1John 1:8 If we say that we have no sin, we deceive ourselves, and the truth is not in us.

9 If we confess our sins, He is faithful and just to forgive us our sins, and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness.

Note: These 5 steps, can be reached quickly, and can be completed with prayers, a few visits and phone calls. At this point your head may spin and your emotions at an all high level. Take a few moments to look back at what you have done so positively for your life. Look at this new change in your spiritual life, and thank God and Jesus for these wonderful things that take place the last 5 steps. Victory is only a few steps away, where you will be in a Holy place, at this stage Jesus is walking right next to you, all the way to Step 9.

If you are 100 % happy that you completed all steps to this point, and mastered it to perfection, the move on to Step 6. The half way make of your Road to Paradise.

Step 6: Water Baptism.

This step seals your decision to follow Jesus and make Heaven your home. You have now chosen a new life in Christ and are on the right road to Heaven. You are already a Citizen of the Kingdom of God.

Now you have to follow your new found friend's example the perfect example of our faith. Follow Jesus through the Baptism of Water. The Baptism of water manifests and proves your faith to your family, friends and even enemies that

you have selected a new life with the Trinity. It's a proof of your old life that died of buried in a grave of water, and risen like Christ as a new creation.

Washed in the new covenant, washed clean and now finally rinsed to perfection. Take this step as final proof of your new found faith. Invite friends and family member to this happy funeral day and happy resurrection day.

You have risen as a new person ready to move to the next step. Baptism signifies repentance.

Mat 3:11 I indeed baptize you with water to repentance. But He who comes after me is mightier than I, whose sandals I am not worthy to carry. He shall baptize you with the Holy Spirit and with fire; All followers of Jesus should be baptized. Mat 28:19 therefore go and teach all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit.

Jesus was baptized in water.

Mark 1:9 and it happened in those days that Jesus came from Nazareth of Galilee and was baptized by John in the Jordan Baptism is closely linked to a changed life.

Act 2:38 Then Peter said to them, Repent and be baptized, every one of you, in the name of Jesus Christ to remission of sins, and you shall receive the gift of the Holy Spirit.

All new Christians should be baptized.

Act 8:12 But when they believed Philip preaching the gospel, the things concerning the kingdom of God and the name of Jesus Christ, they were baptized, both men and women.

13 Then Simon himself believed also, and being baptized, he continued with Philip. And seeing miracles and mighty works happening, he was amazed.

14 And the apostles in Jerusalem hearing that Samaria had received the Word of God, they sent Peter and John to them;

15 who when they had come down, prayed for them that they might receive the Holy Spirit.

16 For as yet He had not fallen on any of them, they were baptized only in the name of the Lord Jesus.

17 Then they laid their hands on them, and they received the Holy Spirit.

Baptism initiates us in Christ.

Rom 6:3 Do you not know that as many of us as were baptized into Jesus Christ

were baptized into His death?

4 Therefore we were buried with Him by baptism into death, so that as Christ was raised up from the dead by the glory of the Father; even so we also should walk in newness of life.

5 for if we have been joined together in the likeness of His death, we shall also be in the likeness of His resurrection;

6 knowing this, that our old man is crucified with Him in order that the body of sin might be destroyed, that from now on we should not serve sin.

7 For he who died has been justified from sin.

8 but if we died with Christ, we believe that we shall also live with Him,

Salvation is identified with Baptism.

1 Peter 3:21 which figure now also saves us, baptism; not a putting away of the filth of the flesh, but the answer of a good conscience toward God, by the resurrection of Jesus Christ;

After this step, you are now a “New Born Christian”. But not 100% out of the woods yet!

You are now a new person with a new blank page in your life, and everybody will see the change in you. Yes, not all is moonlight and roses. You have to realize you will lose friends and even family will start reacting badly towards you. (Those ones, still in the World with sin in their lives). But now you can make new friend within the same group as you, the washed clean from sin, born again, on the way to Heaven.

At this point a large percentage of Christian normally stagnate and even fall back, due to the attacks from the wolfs, now you need more assistance from Jesus, God and your new Christian friends, to pray for you and with you to reach the safe grounds of the Holy Spirit Baptism.

The problem is when you fall back to a sinful life in the World again; it is very difficult to come back to this point of your spiritual life. Only a hand full return back to step 7 most will be lost, sorry to say. Satan now's this better than you, and he will try his upmost best to keep you away from Heaven.

Remember, if you do fall back, Jesus will leave the 99 sheep and come and look for you, He is the Good Sheppard.

This is my personal opinion.

I believe this is where the modern Church falters, at this point they leave the New Born to fend for themselves, and at this point a pack of wolves are waiting for you, you need protection, guidance and a leader to walk with you the rest of the way, up to step 10 at least.

Please ask the altar worker, the Pastor or Evangelist to walk with you the rest of the way, Yes Jesus is with you in Spirit, but you need somebody with guidance (Living in this time frame) to help you throw the dangers of this World.

Step 7: Bible Study.

Start eating from the word of God – Read, Study the Good News Bible, join study group, joins a healthy Church (Ask Jesus to lead you to one). Listen to sermons, praise and worship the Trinity, grow, grow, grow.

Come into contact and have interaction with other Christians, and even other Spirit filled Children of God, that is on adulthood at Step 10 in their lives.

Start memorizing verses from the Bible that you will learn to love, build on your newly found Mustard seed faith. Remember, there will still be small sin in your life, and your friends and family will sin against you, yes and even some of your fellow Christians will sin against you, on your root to Paradise. Make a stand in your life today. Forgive instantly, and ask God for forgiveness of your sin, every day. This is not the sin that you left on Step 2. No small sin. If I can call it that, but with God sin is sin, small or large. Remember you are walking with Jesus Christ, I'm dead curtain He will lead you away from sin, listen to that small voice.

Read you're Bible, Pray every day, forgive instantly, keep walking away from sin and build on your new found faith.

Start listening for God's voice.

Eat The Word of God. It's sweeter than honey.

And use your Bible to shield yourself against Satan.

Step 8: Prayer, Building on Faith and Continues forgiveness.

Learn to Pray, Build your Faith and continually give and receive forgiveness. Start with a prayer relationship within the Trinity, Pray and Listen. Let God also speak to you.

Remember to forgive 70*7 daily. And remind God that He promised to forgive you. Your sin as you forgave those that sinned against you.

Pray without giving up!

Note: that minor sin will still appear in your life, but they will soon disappear. As soon as you have mastered step 8, the Holy Spirit is already standing on step 9, to baptize you with Fire and Power.

The next step the MOST important step you will ever make in this life and the coming life.

You need to request the Holy Spirit to baptize you, He is a Gentleman, He will wait for your invite, and He will never force Himself on you.

Not that the Holy Spirit will be waiting, and when you are ready and very important –sin free- "The Comforter Baptism Team" will approach you and fill you with a host of Character, Abilities, Gifts and Fruits of the Trinity.

Ask God for help!

Psalm 40:13 be pleased, O Jehovah, to deliver me; O Jehovah, make haste to help me.

God will not listen to our prayers if we are purposely sinning.

Mica 3:4 Then they shall cry to Jehovah, but He will not answer them. He will even hide His face from them at that time, as they have done evil in their doings.

Prayer should not be a show.

Mat 6:6 but you, when you pray, enter into your room. And shutting your door,

pray to your Father in secret; and your Father who sees in secret shall reward you openly.

Jesus teaches us to pray.

Mat 6:9 Therefore pray in this way: Our Father, who is in Heaven, Hallowed be Your name.

10 Your kingdom come, Your will be done, on earth as it is in Heaven.

11 Give us this day our daily bread;

12 and forgive us our debts as we also forgive our debtors.

13 And lead us not into temptation, but deliver us from the evil. For Yours is the kingdom, and the power, and the glory, forever. Amen.

Pray with humbleness.

Luke 18:9 And He spoke this parable to certain ones who trusted in themselves that they were righteous, and despised others:

10 Two men went up into the temple to pray; the one a Pharisee, and the other a tax-collector.

11 The Pharisee stood and prayed within himself in this way: God, I thank You that I am not as other men are, extortioners, unjust, adulterers, or even like this tax-collector.

12 I fast twice on the Sabbath; I give tithes of all that I possess.

13 And standing afar off, the tax-collector would not even lift up his eyes to Heaven, but struck on his breast, saying, God be merciful to me a sinner!

14 I tell you, this man went down to his house justified rather than the other. For everyone who exalts himself shall be abased, and he who humbles himself shall be exalted.

Pray in the name of Jesus Christ.

John 16:23 and in that day you shall ask Me nothing. Truly, truly, I say to you, whatever you shall ask the Father in My name, He will give you. 24 before now you have asked nothing in My name; ask and you shall receive, that your joy may be full.

Pray all the time.

Eph 6:18 praying always with all prayer and supplication in the Spirit and watching to this very thing with all perseverance and supplication for all saints.

Pray without doubting.

James 1:6 but let him ask in faith, doubting nothing. For he who doubts is like a wave of the sea, driven by the wind and tossed.

Pray with the right motives.

James 4:3 you ask and receive not, because you ask amiss, that you may spend it upon your lusts.

Pray according to God's will.

1Jn 5:14 and this is the confidence that we have toward Him, that if we ask anything according to His will, He hears us.

15 And if we know that He hears us, whatever we ask, we know that we have the petitions that we desired of Him.

Pray without giving up.

Luke 18:1 and He also spoke a parable to them to teach it is always right to pray, and not to faint,

Have Faith when praying.

Mat 21:22 If you believe, you will receive whatever you ask for in prayer.”

Forgive and you will be forgiven.

Mat 6:9 Therefore pray in this way: Our Father, who is in Heaven, Hallowed be Your name.

10 Your kingdom come, Your will be done, on earth as it is in Heaven.

11 Give us this day our daily bread;

12 and forgive us our debts as we also forgive our debtors.

13 And lead us not into temptation, but deliver us from the evil. For Yours is the kingdom, and the power, and the glory, forever. Amen.

Pray, forgive, believe and Receive.

Step 9: The Baptism of the Holy Spirit

(“Not Just a Spirit”)

This step is fully covered in my Book – Not just a Spirit. In this revelation from God you will see that this step is the most important step in your whole life.

Even more important than

goosing a life partner, even more important in purchasing a valuable Asset.

At this stage you are super clean – totally sin free. Your prayer life is super fantastic, you forgive instantly, and your mustard seed faith has germinated and is busy growing in to a young tree.

Only when the Baptism takes place, then you can turn towards Heaven and know that Heaven will defiantly be your final destination, The Holy Spirit now within you leads you away from sin – and towards the Capital City of the Kingdom of

Heaven. And if you can stay within the Spirit, He will finally seal you with the Mark of God. Set you Apart as Holy to the Lord -Sealed for Eternity.

At this stage you will receive a combination of Abilities, Gifts and Fruits of the Spirit to equip you for your Discipleship and your Ministry.

Any very important and these many Theologies miss. You will be equipped with some Characteristics of God and Jesus. Like a Feast of Love, Peace, Patience, Wisdom and more.

The 9 Fruits of the Spirit

Gal 5:22 -23

But the fruit of the Spirit

Is love – Joy – Peace – Long-suffering – Gentleness -Goodness – Faith – Meekness -Temperance?

The 9 Gifts of the Spirit

1Cor 12:1 now concerning spiritual gifts, brothers, I would not have you ignorant.

2 You know that being led away; you nations were led to dumb idols.

3 Therefore I make known to you that no one speaking by the Spirit of God says Jesus is a curse, and that no one can say that Jesus is Lord, but by the Holy Spirit.

4 but there are differences of gifts, but the same Spirit.

5 And there are differences of ministries, but the same Lord.

6 And there are differences of workings, but it is the same God working all things in all.

7 But to each one is given the showing forth of the Spirit to our profit.

8 for through the Spirit is given to one a word of wisdom; and to another a word of knowledge, according to the same Spirit;

9 and to another faith by the same Spirit; and to another the gifts of healing by the same Spirit;

10 and to another workings of powers, to another prophecy; and to another discerning of spirits; and to another kinds of tongues; and to another the interpretation of tongues.

11 but the one and the same Spirit works all these things, distributing separately to each one as He desires.

12 For as the body is one and has many members, and all the members of that one body, being many, are one body; so also is Christ.

13 for also by one Spirit we are all baptized into one body, whether Jews or Greeks, whether bond or free, even all were made to drink into one Spirit.

14 for the body is not one member, but many.
15 If the foot shall say, because I am not the hand, I am not of the body; is it therefore not of the body?
16 And if the ear shall say, because I am not the eye, I am not of the body; is it therefore not of the body?
17 If all the body were an eye, where would be the hearing? If all hearing, where would be the smelling?
18 but now God has set the members, each one of them, in the body as it has pleased Him.
19 And if they were all one member, where would be the body?
20 but now indeed many are the members, yet only one body.
21 And the eye cannot say to the hand, I have no need of you; or again the head to the feet; I have no need of you.
22 But much rather the members of the body seeming to be weaker are necessary.
23 And those members of the body which we think to be less honorable, on these we put more abundant honor around them. And our unpresentable members have more abundant propriety.
24 for our presentable members have no need, but God tempered the body together, giving more abundant honor to the member having need;
25 that there not be division in the body, but that the members should have the same care for one another.
26 And if one member suffers, all the members suffer with it; if one member is glorified, all the members rejoice with it.
27 And you are the body of Christ, and members in part.
28 And God set some in the church, firstly, apostles; secondly, prophets; thirdly, teachers, then works of power, then gifts of healings, helps, governments, kinds of languages.
29 Are all apostles? Are all prophets? Are all teachers? Are all workers of power?
30 Do all have gifts of healings? Do all speak languages? Do all interpret?
31 But zealously strive after the better gifts. And yet I show to you a more excellent way.

Jesus was baptized with the Spirit.

John 1:32 and John bore record, saying, I saw the Spirit descending from Heaven like a dove, and He abode on Him.

33 And I did not know Him, but He who sent me to baptize with water that one said to me, upon whom you shall see the Spirit descending, and remaining upon Him, He is the One who baptizes with the Holy Spirit.

Jesus received the filling of the Spirit.

Mat 3:16 And Jesus, when He had been baptized, went up immediately out of the water. And lo, the heavens were opened to Him, and He saw the Spirit of God descending like a dove and lighting upon Him.

Led by the Holy Spirit

Rom 8:14 for as many as are led by the Spirit of God, they are the sons of God.

Pentecost – the Baptism of the Holy Spirit

Act 2:2 and suddenly a sound came out of the heaven as borne along by the rushing of a mighty wind, and it filled all the house where they were sitting.

3 And tongues as of fire appeared to them, being distributed; and it sat upon each of them.

4 And they were all filled of the Holy Spirit, and began to speak in other languages, as the Spirit gave them utterance.

38 Then Peter said to them, repent and be baptized, every one of you, in the name of Jesus Christ to remission of sins, and you shall receive the gift of the Holy Spirit.

Step 10: Accepting your discipleship. The Great Commission from Jesus as per Matt 28 v 19 Go (After you waited in Jerusalem for the Baptism of the Comforter and received the Baptism of the Holy Spirit) and make new disciples from every Nation. Teach them all things as I have taught you (Take and lead them throw the 12 Steps to Heaven) and be sure of this. (Make dead certain they reach Step 9 and monitor them to reach step 10). Lead them to Jesus, assist them to the Baptism of the Holy Spirit.

The 3+9= Chapter.

Walk upwards with them to Step 10 and keep praying for them to reach step 11 in their Spiritual life. So that they will final inherit Heaven our final Home.

Spirit filled Children of God should make new disciples. Mat 28:19

Therefore go and teach all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit,

20 teaching them to observe all things, whatever I commanded you. And, behold, I am with you all the days until the end of the world. Amen.

Christ followers are known by their love.

John 13:35 by this all shall know that you are My disciples, if you have love toward one another.

Christians should help other Christians on their road to Heaven.

Act 14:21 and preaching the gospel to that city, and having made many disciples, they returned to Lystra and Iconium and Antioch, 22 confirming the souls of the disciples, calling on them to continue in the faith and that through much tribulation we must enter into the kingdom of God.

1. Make new Disciples from all Nations.
2. Lead them to Jesus.
3. Baptize them in water.
4. Baptize them in the Holy Spirit.
5. Teach them everything Jesus teaches you.
6. And make sure they reach Heaven.

Step 11: Receiving the Mark (Seal) of God to Eternal life.

Living with Eternity on my mind – Making new disciples, letting the Holy Spirit Lead and comfort you, build in the Spirit, Bare the Fruits of the Spirit you received, Use you Spirit filled abilities, Show the Character of the Trinity with Family, friends and extremely important your enemies. Use your Gifts of the Spirit to build the Kingdom of God, and use it within the Body (Church) of God.

And make sure you receive the “Mark of God” to be “Set apart as Holy to the Lord” sealed with the 999.Holy, Holy, Holy, to the Almighty God

You can only sing this after the Great White Throne Judgment with the rest of Heaven.

Eternal life is only for those who do the will of God. Mat 25:46 and these shall go away into everlasting punishment, but the righteous into everlasting life.

The righteous will receive Eternal Life.

John 3:15 so that whosoever believes in Him should not perish, but have everlasting life.

16 For God so loved the world that He gave His only-begotten Son, that whoever believes in Him should not perish but have everlasting life.

Evil people will receive eternal punishment. John 5:28 Do not marvel at this, for the hour is coming in which all who are in the graves shall hear His voice, 29 and shall come forth, those who have done good to the resurrection of life, and those who have practiced evil to the resurrection of condemnation.

Jesus came to give us Eternal Life.

John 10:10 the thief does not come except to steal and to kill and to destroy. I have come so that they might have life, and that they might have it more abundantly.

John 11:25 Jesus said to her, I am the Resurrection and the Life! He who believes in Me, though he die, yet he shall live.

Jesus is Eternal Life!

John 14:6 Jesus said to him, I am the Way, the Truth, and the Life; no one comes to the Father but by Me.

Eternal Life comes from God.

Tit 1:2 on hope of eternal life, which God, who cannot lie, promised before the eternal times,

Eph 2:8 for by grace you are saved through faith, and that not of yourselves, it is the gift of God,

Eph 2:9 not of works, lest anyone should boast.

Eternal Life gives us Hope.

Tit 3:7 that being justified by His grace, we should become heirs according to the hope of eternal life.

Step 12: The Eternal Life – Heaven our Home.

Only 2 ways in getting to Heaven – Naturally when you reach step 11 in your spiritual life next step is leaving this World. The first way is dying and the second the Rapture when you are still alive when Jesus comes to collect His Bride and take you Home to the place He went to prepare for you.

Step 12 after death – the first death as mention in the word of God. And after the Great White Throne Judgment, when the final book is opened by the Lamb of God Jesus will open this final book. And your final destination will be revealed.

Heaven or Hell

But if you follow these steps and master it to the finest detail, Heaven will be you next Home.

Jesus will show us the splendour of Heaven.

Rev 7:13 and one of the elders answered, saying to me, who are these who are arrayed in white robes, and from where do they come?

14 And I said to him, Sir, you know. And he said to me, these are the ones who came out of the great tribulation and have washed their robes, and have whitened them in the blood of the Lamb.

15 Therefore they are before the throne of God, and they serve Him day and night in His temple. And He sitting on the throne will dwell among them.

16 They will not hunger any more, nor thirst any more, nor will the sun light on them, nor any heat.

17 For the Lamb who is in the midst of the throne will feed them and will lead them to the fountains of living waters. And God will wipe away all tears from their eyes.

Only a few will find Heaven.

Mat 7:13 Go in through the narrow gate, for wide is the gate and broad is the way that leads to destruction, and many there are who go in through it.

14 Because narrow is the gate and constricted is the way which leads to life, and there are few who find it.

Only Righteous people will enter Heaven.

John 14:2 In My Father's house are many mansions; if it were not so, I would have told you. I go to prepare a place for you.

3 And if I go and prepare a place for you, I will come again and receive you to Myself, so that where I am, you may be also.

2 Co 5:2 for indeed in this we groan, earnestly desiring to be clothed with our dwelling-place out of Heaven;

Jesus is currently preparing a place for you in Heaven.

John 14:2 In My Father's house are many mansions; if it were not so, I would have told you. I go to prepare a place for you.

3 And if I go and prepare a place for you, I will come again and receive you to Myself, so that where I am, you may be also.

4 And where I go you know, and the way you know.

Our lives will not be complete without Heaven.

2 Cor 5:2 for indeed in this we groan, earnestly desiring to be clothed with our dwelling-place out of Heaven;

Look forward to Heaven.

Col 3:1 if then you were raised with Christ, seek those things which are above, where Christ is sitting at the right hand of God.

2 Be mindful of things above, not on things on the earth.

3 For you died, and your life has been hidden with Christ in God.

4 When Christ our Life is revealed, then you also will be revealed with Him in glory.

5 Therefore put to death your members which are on the earth: fornication, uncleanness, passion, evil desire, and covetousness (which is idolatry),

Heaven is our Home!

2Pe 3:13 But according to His promise, we look for new heavens and a new earth in which righteousness dwells.

One day we will be with God in Heaven.

Rev 22:5 and there will be no night there. And they need no lamp, or light of the sun; for the Lord God gives them light. And they will reign forever and ever.

According to Jesus in John 3 verse 3

Jesus answered and said to him, Truly, truly, I say to you, Unless a man is born again, he cannot see the kingdom of God

And again in John 3 verse 5

Jesus answered, Truly, truly, I say to you, Unless a man is born of water and the Spirit, he cannot enter into the kingdom of God We will not be able to even see the Kingdom of God and no one will enter the Kingdom of God, this shows two different actions in the Born again process of the spiritual life.

If you ever experience the Birth of a Baby, you will be able to compare the 12 steps to Heaven with this fantastic God given process. You will be able to compare every phase of a baby's birth with the step that will lead you to Eternity.

The Church of the modern World, does not understand this process fully – the process of re birth they thing the re-birth end at the baptism of water, after you accepted Jesus Christ into your life. Then they call this person a born again Christian.

(Joh 15:26) But when the Comforter is come, whom I will send unto you from the Father, even the Spirit of truth, which proceedeth from the Father, he shall testify of me:

(Joh 16:7) Nevertheless I tell you the truth; It is expedient for you that I go away: for if I go not away, the Comforter will not come unto you; but if I depart, I will send him unto you.

Equipping us to be Part of the Kingdom of God!

By pouring into us, His Fire with Power. With Gifts and Fruits of the Spirit!

(Eph 3:5) Which in other ages was not made known unto the sons of men, as it is now revealed unto his holy apostles and prophets by the Spirit;

1Co 12:4 Now there are diversities of gifts, but the same Spirit.

1Co 12:5 And there are differences of administrations, but the same Lord.

1Co 12:6 And there are diversities of operations, but it is the same God which worketh all in all. 1Co 12:7 But the manifestation of the Spirit is given to every man to profit withal.

1Co 12:8 For to one is given by the Spirit the word of wisdom; to another the word of knowledge by the same Spirit;

1Co 12:9 To another faith by the same Spirit; to another the gifts of healing by the same Spirit;

1Co 12:10 To another the working of miracles; to another prophecy; to another discerning of spirits; to another divers kinds of tongues; to another the interpretation of tongues:

Gal 5:22 But the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, longsuffering, gentleness, goodness, faith,

Gal 5:23 Meekness, temperance: against such there is no law.

We need the Holy Spirit Baptism now more than Ever!

(Joh 1:33) And I knew him not: but he that sent me to baptize with water, the same said unto me, Upon whom thou shalt see the Spirit descending, and remaining on him, the same is he which baptizeth with the Holy Ghost.

1Ti 4:1 Now the Spirit speaketh expressly, that in the latter times some shall depart from the faith, giving heed to seducing spirits, and doctrines of devils; 1st ly to lead us to the End time Fruit of the Spirit. Being "Patience" and equipping us with the End time Gift. Being "Faith".

(2Th 1:4) So that we ourselves glory in you in the churches of God for your patience and faith in all your persecutions and tribulations that ye endure:

(Heb 6:12) That ye be not slothful, but followers of them who through faith and patience inherit the promises.

(Rev 14:12) Here is the patience of the saints: here are they that keep the commandments of God, and the faith of Jesus.

The Leadership role of the Holy Spirit will increase into leading us through the coming Economic meltdown of the World

1Jn 4:6 We are of God: he that knoweth God heareth us; he that is not of God heareth not us. Hereby know we the spirit of truth, and the spirit of error.

Eph 6:18 Praying always with all prayer and supplication in the Spirit, and watching thereunto with all perseverance and supplication for all saints;

Eph 1:17 That the God of our Lord Jesus Christ, the Father of glory, may give unto you the spirit of wisdom and revelation in the knowledge of him:

Helping us to identify the False Prophet and the Antichrist!

(1Co 12:3) Wherefore I give you to understand, that no man speaking by the Spirit of God calleth Jesus accursed: and that no man can say that Jesus is the Lord, but by the Holy Ghost.

1Jn 4:3 And every spirit that confesseth not that Jesus Christ is come in the flesh is not of God: and this is that spirit of antichrist, whereof ye have heard that it should come; and even now already is it in the world.

1Jn 4:1 Beloved, believe not every spirit, but try the spirits whether they are of God: because many false prophets are gone out into the world.

Then during the Peace Agreement Time powering us with Fire to evangelize like never before with Truth!

(Eph 1:13) In whom ye also trusted, after that ye heard the word of truth, the gospel of your salvation: in whom also after that ye believed, ye were sealed with that Holy Spirit of promise,

Mar 13:11 But when they shall lead you, and deliver you up, take no thought beforehand what ye shall speak, neither do ye premeditate: but whatsoever shall be given you in that hour, that speak ye: for it is not ye that speak, but the Holy Ghost.

Luk 4:18 The Spirit of the Lord is upon me, because he hath anointed me to preach the gospel to the poor; he hath sent me to heal the brokenhearted, to preach deliverance to the captives, and recovering of sight to the blind, to set at liberty them that are bruised,

Then pouring out the Spirit into us for the Last time at the Last Great Revival during the 1st Part of the 7 Year Peace Agreement! Just before the Great Tribulation, the Wrath of God and the 2nd Coming of Jesus Christ

Act 2:17 And it shall come to pass in the last days, saith God, I will pour out of my Spirit upon all flesh: and your sons and your daughters shall prophesy, and your young men shall see visions, and your old men shall dream dreams:

Act 2:18 And on my servants and on my handmaidens I will pour out in those days of my Spirit; and they shall prophesy:

Act 2:19 And I will shew wonders in heaven above, and signs in the earth beneath; blood, and fire, and vapour of smoke:

Act 2:20 The sun shall be turned into darkness, and the moon into blood, before that great and notable day of the Lord come:

Act 2:21 And it shall come to pass, that whosoever shall call on the name of the Lord shall be saved.

And then His Comforting Role will be needed when we need to leave all our Luxuries and current home behind when the 666 are implemented!

Jud 1:17 But, beloved, remember ye the words which were spoken before of the apostles of our Lord Jesus Christ;

Jud 1:18 How that they told you there should be mockers in the last time, who should walk after their own ungodly lusts.

Jud 1:19 These be they who separate themselves, sensual, having not the Spirit.

Jud 1:20 But ye, beloved, building up yourselves on your most holy faith, praying in the Holy Ghost,

Jud 1:21 Keep yourselves in the love of God, looking for the mercy of our Lord Jesus Christ unto eternal life.

Jud 1:22 And of some have compassion, making a difference:

Jud 1:23 And others save with fear, pulling them out of the fire; hating even the garment spotted by the flesh.

Jud 1:24 Now unto him that is able to keep you from falling, and to present you faultless before the presence of his glory with exceeding joy,

Jud 1:25 To the only wise God our Saviour, be glory and majesty, dominion and power, both now and ever. Amen.

Then we need the Leading Power of the Holy Spirit to guide us to Safety to flee the Antichrist that wants to enforce the Mark of the Beast unto us!

(Luk 4:1) and was led by the Spirit into the wilderness,

(Rev 13:10) He that leadeth into captivity shall go into captivity: he that killeth with the sword must be killed with the sword. Here is the patience and the faith of the saints.

O ye of little faith?

Mat 6:31 Therefore take no thought, saying, What shall we eat? or, What shall we drink? or, Wherewithal shall we be clothed?

Mat 6:32 (For after all these things do the Gentiles seek:) for your heavenly Father knoweth that ye have need of all these things.

Mat 6:33 But seek ye first the kingdom of God, and his righteousness; and all these things shall be added unto you.

Mat 6:34 Take therefore no thought for the morrow: for the morrow shall take thought for the things of itself. Sufficient unto the day is the evil thereof.

But there will be a time the Holy Spirit will leave Earth!

Rev 4:5 And out of the throne proceeded lightnings and thunderings and voices: and there were seven lamps of fire burning before the throne, which are the seven Spirits of God.

Just after we receive the Mark or Seal of God on our Foreheads. Marking us as set apart as Holy to the Lord!

(Eph 4:30) And grieve not the Holy Spirit of God, whereby ye are sealed unto the day of redemption.

Rev 7:2 And I saw another angel ascending from the east, having the seal of the living God: and he cried with a loud voice to the four angels, to whom it was given to hurt the earth and the sea,

Rev 7:3 Saying, Hurt not the earth, neither the sea, nor the trees, till we have sealed the servants of our God in their foreheads.

Rev 9:4 And it was commanded them that they should not hurt the grass of the

earth, neither any green thing, neither any tree; but only those men which have not the seal of God in their foreheads.

The last task of the Holy Spirit will be, leading us into Psalm 91 Protection. Handing us to the Angels that will protect and feed us until the 2nd Coming of Jesus Christ!

Psa 91:1 He that dwelleth in the secret place of the most High shall abide under the shadow of the Almighty.

Psa 91:2 I will say of the LORD, He is my refuge and my fortress: my God; in him will I trust.

Psa 91:3 Surely he shall deliver thee from the snare of the fowler, and from the noisome pestilence.

Psa 91:4 He shall cover thee with his feathers, and under his wings shalt thou trust: his truth shall be thy shield and buckler.

Psa 91:5 Thou shalt not be afraid for the terror by night; nor for the arrow that flieth by day;

Psa 91:6 Nor for the pestilence that walketh in darkness; nor for the destruction that wasteth at noonday.

Psa 91:7 A thousand shall fall at thy side, and ten thousand at thy right hand; but it shall not come nigh thee.

Psa 91:8 Only with thine eyes shalt thou behold and see the reward of the wicked.

Psa 91:9 Because thou hast made the LORD, which is my refuge, even the most High, thy habitation;

Psa 91:10 There shall no evil befall thee, neither shall any plague come nigh thy dwelling.

Psa 91:11 For he shall give his angels charge over thee, to keep thee in all thy ways.

Psa 91:12 They shall bear thee up in their hands, lest thou dash thy foot against a stone.

Psa 91:13 Thou shalt tread upon the lion and adder: the young lion and the dragon shalt thou trample under feet.

Psa 91:14 Because he hath set his love upon me, therefore will I deliver him: I will set him on high, because he hath known my name.

Psa 91:15 He shall call upon me, and I will answer him: I will be with him in trouble; I will deliver him, and honour him.

Psa 91:16 With long life will I satisfy him, and shew him my salvation.

The Holy Spirit will then leave us but full of the Holy Spirit Fire and Power for we will need this for the Lift off to the Rapture when Jesus Arrive on the Clouds.

(Rev 21:10) And He carried me away in the spirit to a great and high mountain, and shewed me that great city, the holy Jerusalem, descending out of heaven from God,

Rev 22:17 And the Spirit and the bride say, Come. And let him that heareth say, Come. And let him that is athirst come. And whosoever will, let him take the water of life freely.

Rev 11:11 And after three days and an half the Spirit of life from God entered into them, and they stood upon their feet; and great fear fell upon them which saw them.

Rev 11:12 And they heard a great voice from heaven saying unto them, Come up hither. And they ascended up to heaven in a cloud; and their enemies beheld them.

You and Your Family Needs the Baptism if the Holy Spirit.

As soon as possible.

For you to make it through what is coming soon! AND make it to Heaven not only the Rapture.

Joh 3:5 Jesus answered, Verily, verily, I say unto thee, Except a man be born of water and of the Spirit, he cannot enter into the kingdom of God.

Joh 3:6 That which is born of the flesh is flesh; and that which is born of the Spirit is spirit.

(Act 2:4) And they were all filled with the Holy Ghost, and began to speak with other tongues, as the Spirit gave them utterance.

Learn how to receive the Holy Spirit and experience all God has for you...

The Bible shows us that God wants to give us the greatest gift you can think of: He comes to live inside of us with his own holy, almighty, wonderful Spirit. He wants us to receive the Holy Spirit so we can experience heaven on earth, God's kingdom becoming reality in our life.

The problem with many Christians is that they don't experience God as a reality. God seems to be far away from them. Their prayers seem to be ineffective. Their faith is weak and they lack the boldness to tell others about Jesus Christ.

Christians perform many religious activities but it is questionable whether it bears as much lasting fruit as we would like to see. What is the cause of that? It is because we do too much in our own strength. We do not realize which

wonderful gift God wants to give us.

Jesus Christ wants you to receive the Holy Spirit, who helps you in your Christian life.

The Holy Spirit elevates the Christian life to a whole new level, where God can really meet us and He becomes an awesome reality in our daily life. The difference between the Old and the New Testament is not only that Jesus Christ died for our sins. It stretches far beyond. The difference is also that God is no longer distant.

God came close. He lives in us and with us. He wants to fill us with his Spirit.

He wants to become a reality for us that is so beautiful and special, as if we are experiencing heaven on earth. Of course with persecution because it is still the earth, where we wage war against the powers of darkness. But we are able to get to know God as a wonderful, intimate reality. His light can shine so amazingly bright in our lives. His love can fill our hearts and control our actions. His goodness can flood us and his peace can govern us. God's reality isn't something we will experience much later, after we die. No, God is here and now with us and wants to baptize us in his Holy Spirit.

How to receive the Holy Spirit

The Bible shows us 5 steps that every person needs to take, in order to receive the baptism of the Spirit.

Step 1. Repent of your Sins and do them no more!

'Repent, and each of you be baptized in the name of Jesus Christ for the forgiveness of your sins; and you will receive the gift of the Holy Spirit.' (Acts 2:38)

Do not be like others who want to replace the clear truth of the Bible by human traditions and reasoning. Don't be inhibited from the wonderful glory that God wants to give you. Read what the Bible says and do what the Bible says.

2) Start a new life

Of course the first step is to repent of your life without God, your life in sin, dishonesty, impurity. Repentance is the basis. Turn away from evil, towards God. Start a completely new life with God.

3) Believe in Jesus Christ

Believe in Jesus Christ as your saviour. Realize that Jesus Christ is the saviour of mankind and died for your sins on the cross at Golgotha. He shed his blood as a

sacrifice for the sins of man. If you believe in Him and bow down for Him, your sins will be forgiven.

4) Be baptized

be baptized in water. That is a basic act that goes together with conversion. In many traditional churches baptism has been replaced by infant baptism. But Jesus Christ let himself be baptized in water, so who are we to claim that we are more than the Son of God and we don't need to be baptized? Jesus was dedicated and blessed as a child, but He still was baptized when He started His ministry.

'After being baptized, Jesus came up immediately from the water; and behold, the heavens were opened, and he saw the Spirit of God descending as a dove on Him.' (Matthew 3:16)

Every Christian who wants to be filled with the Holy Spirit would be advised to follow Jesus Christ's example. Jesus Christ is the Son of God... and He was filled with the Spirit of God when He was baptized in water.

5) Receive the Spirit

When reading the Bible you will notice that the Spirit of God came upon people after they had received prayer with laying on of hands by the apostles.

'Then they began laying their hands on them, and they were receiving the Holy Spirit.' (Acts 8:17)

'Do not neglect the spiritual gift within you, which was bestowed on you through prophetic utterance with the laying on of hands by the presbytery. (1 Timothy 4:14)

In some Christian circles they have replaced the clear biblical truth on this topic by the opinions and traditions of man. But if you are really longing to receive the Holy Spirit, let go of all the human objections and let trustworthy and pure Christians pray for you while laying on hands, just like the Bible tells us.

Chapter 12: Earths Final Drama

1007 Years after the Gog and Magog Battle, 1000 Years after the 2nd coming of Jesus and the Rapture. 1000 years after the Battle of Armageddon, earth's final drama takes place called the Great White Throne Judgment

For 1000 years the Baptised in the Holy Spirit Children of God that was taken into the Golden City. the New Jerusalem , Heaven as we know it and attended the Wedding of the Ages , the Feast of the Bride and the Lam of God and after training as Kings and Rulers of the New Earth . Rev 20:1 And I saw an angel come down from heaven, having the key of the bottomless pit and a great chain in his hand.

Rev 20:2 And he laid hold on the dragon, that old serpent, which is the Devil, and Satan, and bound him a thousand years,

Rev 20:3 And cast him into the bottomless pit, and shut him up, and set a seal upon him, that he should deceive the nations no more, till the thousand years should be fulfilled: and after that he must be loosed a little season.

Rev 20:4 And I saw thrones, and they sat upon them, and judgment was given unto them: and *I saw* the souls of them that were beheaded for the witness of Jesus, and for the word of God, and which had not worshipped the beast, neither his image, neither had received *his* mark upon their foreheads, or in their hands; and they lived and reigned with Christ a thousand years.

Rev 20:5 But the rest of the dead lived not again until the thousand years were finished. This *is* the first resurrection.

Rev 20:6 Blessed and holy *is* he that hath part in the first resurrection: on such the second death hath no power, but they shall be priests of God and of Christ, and shall reign with him a thousand years.

Rev 20:7 And when the thousand years are expired, Satan shall be loosed out of his prison,

Rev 20:8 And shall go out to deceive the nations which are in the four quarters of the earth, Gog and Magog, to gather them together to battle: the number of whom *is* as the sand of the sea.

Rev 20:9 And they went up on the breadth of the earth, and compassed the camp of the saints about, and the beloved city: and fire came down from God out of heaven, and devoured them.

Rev 20:10 And the devil that deceived them was cast into the lake of fire and brimstone, where the beast and the false prophet *are*, and shall be tormented day and night for ever and ever.

Rev 20:11 And I saw a great white throne, and him that sat on it, from whose face the earth and the heaven fled away; and there was found no place for them.

Rev 20:12 And I saw the dead, small and great, stand before God; and the books were opened: and another book was opened, which is *the book* of life: and the dead were judged out of those things which were written in the books, according to their works.

Rev 20:13 And the sea gave up the dead which were in it; and death and hell delivered up the dead which were in them: and they were judged every man according to their works.

Rev 20:14 And death and hell were cast into the lake of fire. This is the second death.

Rev 20:15 And whosoever was not found written in the book of life was cast into the lake of fire.

After they released satan and demons from a pit on a barren Earth. Destroyed very badly with the Wrath of God = The 7 Plaques of Revelation 16 and the Wrath of the Lamb called Armageddon. All the Dead on Earth are resurrected and misled by satan once more to attack the Golden City. The Dead of Gog and Magog are also resurrected from the Place God showed to bury them in a valley next to the Dead Sea 1007 years ago. As they attack the city for take over. Gog and Magog is again killed and destroyed, and the out of the city the Great White Throne appears with Jesus on the Throne to Judge. Now: with all the dead there in front of the throne.
